## St. Francis of Assisi Parish Pastoral Council and Finance Council Joint Meeting December 15, 2021

- 1. <u>Call to Order</u>. The meeting was called to order by Pastoral Council President Brian Cvetezar at 6:00 p.m.
- 2. **Opening Prayer**. Father Doug provided the opening prayer.
- 3. **Open Forum**. No appearances.
- 4. <u>Minutes</u>. The Minutes of the Pastoral Council meeting of November 10, 2021 were approved. Approval of the Minutes of the Finance Council of November 17, 2021 was deferred to the next meeting of the Finance Council.
- 5. **St. Boniface Update.** Father Doug presented a draft of 12/8/21 of the Opening paragraph and paragraph 1 entitled "General Understanding" of the Memorandum of Understanding regarding Boniface church for information purposes only. Father Doug pointed out the provisions adopted by the Pastoral Council at its meeting of November 10, 2021, will be included in the final draft of the MOU. There were no questions.
- 6. **Pastoral Plan/CCS Fundraising**. Father Doug reported that work on the pastoral plan and CCS fundraising continues. The fundraising campaign is in the quiet phase.
- 7. **Discussion of "Ablaze" Book Study**. The group broke into separate discussion groups for Chapters 3 through 8 of the book <u>Ablaze</u>.
