The Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Father Aldrin lead attendees in the Opening Prayer.

1. Minutes from Meetings

Minutes from the April 13 meeting were reviewed and approved.

2. Finance Council Report

Ben Streepey reviewed St. Luke financials for the first 3 quarters of this fiscal year (July, 2021 through March 2022). This report was shared with the parish in Sunday's bulletin. He also reviewed the Profit and Loss statement, with a comparison to the same period last fiscal year.

Ben reported that the Long-Range Planning Committee will look at a Capital Campaign to fund future project.

3. Property Committee Report

Ben Streepey presented a report of Raise the Roof Campaign donations, and informed PPC that fundraising goal was exceeded. The contract has been awarded, and is awaiting final approval from Bishop Stowe. Construction is scheduled to begin late May/early June.

4. Youth Retreat

Ean Klug reported on the Youth Retreat that was held at Andrew Jackson Park in McKee, KY from Friday until Sunday. Tim Shosher, Youth Group leader facilitated the retreat.

Twenty-one individuals from St. Luke attended. Ean reported that it was faith-filled and very rewarding.

5. St. Luke PPC Constitution and Bylaws draft

The PPC approved the Constitution and Bylaws. PPC Members signed the final copy. Theresa reported that the Mission and Vision Statements written at the April retreat will be inserted into the Pastoral Council Constitution and Bylaws once the PPC reviews and approves them.

6. Hispanic Prayer Cards update

Heidi reported that the Hispanic prayer cards have been printed and await lamination. The prayer cards will be utilized at the Hispanic Masses on Sunday evening.

7. Community Outreach – Meals for Manna Meals and Nicholasville Homeless Shelter

Theresa reported that approximately 30 barbeque meals were distributed at the Homeless shelter on April 23. Also, pulled pork for 70 meals was donated to Manna Meals at Nicholasville Methodist Church.

8. Community Outreach-Fiesta May Crowning

The Blessed Mother's May Crowning celebration will be held on Saturday, May 21. Following the Mass and May Crowning, food and activities for the whole family will be offered. Theresa Reynolds is coordinating the celebration.

9. New Business

Father suggested that the PPC plan a churchwide picnic this summer. The PPC recommends having it near the start of the school year. The PPC may solicit help from the Women's' Group and the Knights of Columbus, and contact Chris Frisch to see if he can provide the barbeque. Plans will need to be made in July.
