The church financial reporting is on a fiscal year starting on July 1 and ending June 30 of the following year. The chart above depicts our reported actuals and budget for the full fiscal year.

We are a very blessed parish with very giving parishioners! As a result, our *Total Offertory* was higher than budgeted by \$53,236. However, our *Total Expenses* were also higher than budgeted by \$74,987 primarily due to necessary church rectory, building and grounds, and sanctuary improvements. The *Adj Net Ordinary Income* of \$105,605 was positive due to the required sale of several stock certificates which resulted in a net gain of \$132,929. The *Capital / Restricted Donations* of \$125,320 were reserved for the altar and window restoration projects.

Our balance sheet remains strong with sufficient cash reserves and we are debt free!

This program is for middle and high school students that have not received Catholic Instruction and will receive the sacraments at Easter Vigil. Students will meet from 5:30 - 6:00 PM for formal Catholic teaching, then join the Youth Group for food, fellowship and faith development.
