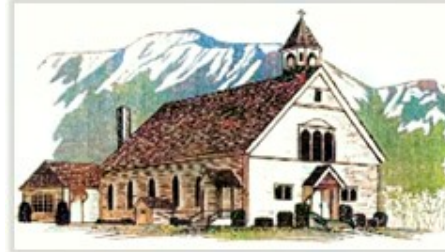

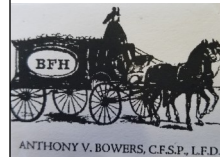

ABIDE will now be held Saturday, December 9, 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., at St. Mary of the Visitation Church, 110 Military Street in Houlton, and Sunday, December 10, 12:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., at St. John Church, 217 York Street in Bangor.</p> <p>Youths in grades 6 -8 are invited to come together to discover the meaning of Jesus' words: "Abide in me, as I abide in you" (Jn 15:4). What does it mean to abide? What does it mean to abide in Christ?
