Vendor Fee:

Limited 10' x 10' outdoor space:

By September 1 \$35 each

After Sept. 1 (if available) \$50 each

Outside electricity is not available, and no indoor Vendor space is available.

Application:

Displayers/Vendors should send 2 color photographs of their Booth, along with their name and addresses on each photo. If photos are not sent, application will be discarded. Send completed application with pictures, along with check for Vendor Booth(s) if applicable. If you have displayed at the Festival in the past, you do not need to submit photos unless your display has changed.

Set Up:

Outdoor Vendors / Display Booths are responsible for their own displays, including tables, chairs and tents. The Festival will be held, rain or shine, and each Vendor should make arrangements for wind or rain. See calendar for set-up times. Notre Dame Church is not responsible for any items set up on Friday night before the Festival, however grounds will be patrolled on a regular basis.

Sales:

All sales must be handled by the Vendor. Local sales tax is the responsibility of the Vendor.

Eligibility:

The sale of food, drinks or raffle tickets are not allowed at the Festival. Notre Dame Church holds the right to the sale of these items during the Fall Festival of Nations.

All applications are subject to approval by the Festival Committee to be in compliance with the event.

Applicants that are accepted will receive acceptance letters and a Hold Harmless Agreement to be submitted to the Festival Committee upon arrival at the event when setting up Booth Display.

Applicants not accepted will receive a notification letter which will include the booth fee checks that accompanied the application, if applicable.

NOTE: All Games and Raffle for three \$500 Cash drawings that are held on the premises during the Fall Festival of Nations is in compliance with the State of Tennessee Gaming Regulations.

Notre Dame Church reserves the right to remove any work or display which does not reflect Christian values, is not in compliance with state or federal regulations or considered to be in poor taste.
