

Gospel Reflection

June 12, 2022 • The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

Glory Be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

There are many rituals and practices that are part and parcel of every Catholic and one of them is the Sign of the Cross. This is often done, for example, before and after prayer, before a meal, when entering and exiting the Church, or even before we begin a journey. We invoke the Trinity with a sign of God's eternal love for us, which is the Cross; a statement of faith. And so, on this Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we celebrate God's love to the world through His Son, which He continues to shower upon us by the working of the Holy Spirit.

The concept of the Trinity is the basic mystery behind all other mysteries of our faith. It reveals to us the unity of one God in three distinct persons and their roles. The Father (*creator*) sent the Son (*redeemer*) to save us by His life and then the Father and the Son, sent the Holy Spirit (*sanctifier*) to fill us with divine life and make us God's children. So, every time we make a Sign of the Cross, we honor God our Father through His Son, Jesus Christ, in unity with the Holy Spirit. This may not be so easy to grasp and that is why we need the power of the Holy Spirit to give us the divine wisdom which Christ promised His disciples to guide and understand these mysteries (Jn 16:12-15).



When we were baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and the Holy Spirit, we were joined to the Trinitarian family. We began a journey to the Father through our different vocations, following the example of the Son who teaches us who the Father is and we get this knowledge with the help of the Holy Spirit. Therefore, the love and unity between the three, is what all of us are called to embrace and practice in our daily lives. As the Son revealed the Father to us, we too must reveal the Son to those who don't know Him because we have the Holy Spirit who guides us and so, we must be the light to the world through words and actions.

We need to also take the Holy Trinity as a model for our families just as the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit are united in love. The love, unity and joy in their relationship should inspire us in our own relationships with one another. We can only be true Christians by living in a good relationship with God and one another. And so, like God the Father, we are called to be creative and productive. Like God the Son, we are called to reconcile and be peace makers and like God the Holy Spirit, we are called upon to teach and tell the truth to the world starting with those close to us. **May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you always. Blessings.**

Next week, we celebrate *Corpus Christi* Sunday, the Feast of the Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. We are going to have a special procession of the Blessed Sacrament through the church after Mass, with Benediction. Please, please, I beg you,

don't leave early on next Sunday! You shouldn't leave early from any Mass you go to, but especially Mass on *Corpus Christi* Sunday. It would be so disrespectful to our Lord present in the Blessed Sacrament as we process around church. If you are one who generally leaves Mass early for whatever reason (usually to avoid traffic in the parking lot), I ask you, with all that is in my heart, to stay till after Benediction and the last hymn, "Holy God We Praise Thy Name."

You know by now that I love Jesus present in the Blessed Sacrament. Christ, the center of our faith and of our Catholic life, is really, truly, substantially present in the Sacred Host consecrated at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. This is no mere devotion or pious practice. It is the heart of our faith. The Eucharist is the embodiment of God's love for us. Just as He came to us as a man 2,000 years ago, He is here with us today, under sacramental signs, truly present before our eyes of faith. Emmanuel! God with us! This must be the most important element in our lives as Christians. Devotion to Christ in the Blessed Sacrament can't be just an optional thing for us.



These days however, Catholics have grown indifferent to the wonder of the *Real Presence*. A recent PEW research poll found that 69% of Catholics believed only in a *symbolic* presence of Christ in the Eucharist. And only 21% of Catholic attend Sunday Mass regularly. Belief in the Eucharistic Presence has never been easy. Even Christ Himself ran into this when He preached about it in Capernaum (see John, chapter 6). In the 1200's, belief was lacking as well. That's when they began to celebrate the Feast of *Corpus Christi*. They didn't sit down and have a class on the *Real Presence*. They emphasized it in the celebration of the Sacrament. In other words, belief comes less from learning and more from practice.

I know that every parishioner of St. Susanna does believe in the *Real Presence* of Christ in the Eucharist. Now is the time to put that belief into practice with more intensity and more intentionality. For example, no more leaving church early! At least stay until the priest and servers finish their procession. There is nothing worse than to have people in front of us blocking the way as we process out of church.

My prayer for all of you is that you dive into your faith in the *Real Presence* and let it marvel you. May you give your Savior Jesus Christ, True God and True Man, present in the Blessed Sacrament, due worship and devotion.

O Sacrament most holy, O Sacrament Divine, all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine!

LA SOLEMNIDAD DE LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD, 12 DE JUNIO DE 2022 AÑO C.

GLORIA AL PADRE, AL HIJO Y AL ESPÍRITU SANTO.

Hay muchos rituales y prácticas que son parte integrante de cada católico y uno de ellos es la señal de la Cruz. Esto se hace a menudo, por ejemplo, antes y después de la oración, antes de una comida, al entrar y salir de la Iglesia o incluso antes de iniciar un viaje. Invocamos a la Trinidad con un signo del amor eterno de Dios por nosotros, que es la Cruz; una declaración de fe. Y así, en esta solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad, celebramos el amor de Dios al mundo a través de Su Hijo, que Él continúa derramando sobre nosotros por la obra del Espíritu Santo. El concepto de la Trinidad es el misterio básico que provienen los demás misterios de nuestra fe. Nos revela la unidad de un solo Dios en tres personas distintas y sus roles. El Padre (*creador*) envió al Hijo (*redentor*) para salvarnos con Su vida y luego el Padre y el Hijo, enviaron al Espíritu Santo (*santificador*) para llenarnos de vida divina y hacernos hijos de Dios. Entonces, cada vez que hacemos la señal de la Cruz, honramos a Dios nuestro Padre a través de Su Hijo Jesucristo en unidad con el Espíritu Santo. Puede no ser fácil de comprender y es por lo cual necesitamos el poder del Espíritu Santo para obtener la sabiduría divina que Cristo prometió a sus discípulos para guiar y para comprender estos misterios (Jn 16: 12-15).

Cuando fuimos bautizados en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo, nos unimos a la familia trinitaria. Iniciamos un camino hacia el Padre a través de nuestras diferentes vocaciones, siguiendo el ejemplo del Hijo que nos enseña quién es el Padre y obtenemos este conocimiento con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo. Por lo tanto, el amor y la unidad entre los tres, es lo que todos nosotros estamos llamados a acoger y practicar en nuestra vida diaria. Así como el Hijo nos reveló al Padre, nosotros también debemos revelar al Hijo a aquellos que no lo conocen porque tenemos el Espíritu Santo que nos guía y, por lo tanto, debemos ser la luz para el mundo a través de palabras y acciones.

Necesitamos también tomar la Santísima Trinidad como modelo para nuestras familias, así como el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo están unidos en el amor. El amor, la unidad y la alegría en su relación deben inspirarnos en nuestras propias relaciones entre nosotros. Sólo podemos ser verdaderos cristianos viviendo en una buena relación con Dios y con los demás. Y así, como Dios Padre, estamos llamados a ser creativos y productivos. Al igual que Dios el Hijo, estamos llamados a reconciliarnos y ser pacificadores y, como Dios el Espíritu Santo, estamos llamados a enseñar y proclamar la verdad al mundo empezando con los seres más cercanos a nosotros. *Que la gracia de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, el amor de Dios y la comunión del Espíritu Santo estén siempre con ustedes.* Bendiciones.

La próxima semana celebramos el Domingo de *Corpus Christi*, la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Vamos a tener una procesión especial del Santísimo Sacramento a través de la iglesia después de la Misa, con la Bendición. Por favor, por favor, se lo ruego, ¡no se vaya temprano el próximo domingo! No debe salir temprano de ninguna Misa a la que va, pero especialmente de la Misa del Domingo de *Corpus Christi*. Sería tan irrespetuoso con nuestro Señor presente en el Santísimo Sacramento mientras procesamos por los alrededores de la iglesia. Si usted es uno de los que generalmente sale temprano de la Misa por cualquier razón (generalmente para evitar el tráfico en el estacionamiento), le pido, con todo lo que está en mi corazón, que se quede hasta después de la Bendición y el último himno, Santo Dios Alabamos Tu Nombre.

Ya a de saber usted como es que yo amo a Jesús presente en el Santísimo Sacramento. Cristo, el centro de nuestra fe y de nuestra vida católica, está realmente, verdaderamente, sustancialmente presente en la Sagrada Hostia consagrada en el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa. Esto no es nada más devoción o práctica piadosa. Es el corazón de nuestra fe. La Eucaristía es la encarnación del amor de Dios por nosotros. Así como Él vino a nosotros como hombre hace 2.000 años, Él está aquí con nosotros hoy, bajo signos sacramentales, verdaderamente presente ante nuestros ojos de fe. ¡Emmanuel! ¡Dios con nosotros! Este debe ser el elemento más importante en nuestras vidas como cristianos. La devoción a Cristo en el Santísimo Sacramento no puede ser solo algo opcional para nosotros.



En estos días, sin embargo, los católicos se han vuelto indiferentes a la maravilla de la Presencia Real. Una encuesta reciente de investigación de PEW encontró que el 69% de los católicos creían solo en una presencia *simbólica* de Cristo en la Eucaristía. Y solo el 21% de los católicos asisten regularmente a la Misa dominical. Creer en la Presencia Eucarística nunca ha sido fácil. Incluso Cristo mismo se topó con esto cuando predicó al respecto en Cafarnaúm (vea Juan, capítulo 6). En la década de 1200, la creencia también faltaba. Fue entonces cuando comenzaron a celebrar la Fiesta del *Corpus Christi*. No se sentaron y tuvieron una clase sobre la Presencia Real. Lo enfatizaron en la celebración del Sacramento. En otras palabras, la creencia proviene menos del aprendizaje y más de la práctica.

Sé que cada feligrés de Santa Susana sí cree en la Presencia Real de Cristo en la Eucaristía. Ahora es el momento de poner en práctica esta creencia con más intensidad y más intencionalidad. Por ejemplo, ¡no más salir temprano de la iglesia! Al menos quédate hasta que el sacerdote y los servidores terminen su procesión. No hay nada peor que tener personas frente a nosotros bloqueando el camino mientras salimos de la iglesia.

Mi oración por todos ustedes es que se sumerjan en su fe en la Presencia Real y dejen que les maraville. Que le dé a su Salvador Jesucristo, Verdadero Dios y Verdadero Hombre, presente en el Santísimo Sacramento, la debida adoración y devoción.

¡Oh Sacramento santísimo, oh Sacramento Divino, toda alabanza y toda acción de gracias sea cada momento Tuyo!
