December 17, 2023 • Third Sunday of Advent

Isaiah 61:1-2a, 10-11; 1 Thes 5:16-24; John 1:6-8, 19-28



Next weekend is going to be a bit packed with church things. The Fourth Sunday of Advent falls on December 24th this year. It will be a very short

4th week of Advent, lasting just a few hours on that Sunday before the 4:00pm Christmas Eve Mass begins. In addition to the 5:00pm Saturday Vigil Mass in English, there will be a 7:00pm Saturday Vigil Mass in Spanish as well. Then on Sunday, December 24th there will only be the 7:30 and 9:30am Masses for that Sunday, no 11:30am Mass. With

Christmas Eve Masses at 4:00, 6:30 and 10:00pm, it would mean you are going to two Masses on that Sunday. Of course, you may go to the vigil on Saturday and to the 9:30am (English Mass) or 11:30am (Spanish Mass) on Christmas Day. Maybe this year you don't go to the early (and very crowded!) Christmas Eve Mass at 4:00pm and you go to another Eve Mass or on Christmas Dav.



Don't shortchange your belonging to the Catholic Church and St. Susanna's Parish, and the obligation to attend Mass on the Fourth Sunday of Advent AND on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day. It should feel less like a duty and more like an opportunity to grow in grace and give glory to God who has come into the world to save us. As Linus says, "That's what Christmas is all about, Charlie Brown." It's not about making merry; it's about becoming holy. That's why Christ was born at Bethlehem – to unite God to us and elevate us to the image of divinity we were made to be. When we come together for the Eucharistic celebration as the Mystical Body of Christ, we see this happen. Jesus is made present in His offering to the Father and we are united to Him in this sacrifice. You have to be there when this happens. You have to come to church in order to make this a reality. Christ and



the Church ask us to participate in these divine mysteries every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation. To miss Mass would be to miss out on this singular chance to receive God's grace and become one in Christ. If you miss it here on earth, there's a good chance you will miss it in eternity where Christ is before His Father in glory surrounded by all the heavenly host in the great banquet of paradise. You don't want to miss out on this! Eternity is a long time! Forever and ever, actually!

So, I hope and pray each and every member of our parish will make the effort to attend Mass on the 4th Sunday of Advent and again on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day. God is waiting for you to take your place in church now and in heaven later. Don't let Him down. Give Him your best! Give Him what He deserves. He is worth it.

May God bless each and every one of you this Christmas!

Catholic Customs Corner: First Saturday Marian Devotion

In 1917, our Lady, the Blessed Mother Mary, appeared to three children in Fatima, Portugal. Two of the children, Jacinta and Francisco, died shortly thereafter. The third child, Lucia, became a nun and lived into her 90's. In 1940, Lucia wrote to the Holy Father, asking him to promulgate the First Five Saturdays in reparation, a devotion that the Blessed Mother told the children to promote.

The purpose of this devotion, which entails receiving Holy Communion on the first Saturday of each month for five consecutive months, was to make reparation for all the insults, sacrileges and indifferences committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Our Lady promised to assist with all the graces needed at the hour of



death for the salvation of all those who fulfilled this devotion. Making reparation means doing personal sacrifices and prayers to repair the damage done by sin and indifference toward God, Jesus and the Blessed Mother. One unites with the sacrifice of Christ on the Cross, which makes their sacrifices efficacious for reparation.

Devotion to Mary, of course, brings a believer closer to Christ her Son. Just as Mary was dear to Jesus, she should be dear to us. We show this by our devotion to her, honoring her as the instrument of God's salvation. Mary should be looked to for inspiration to do God's Will. Entrusting ourselves to her in devotions such as the First Five Saturdays is a sure way to sanctification and Heaven. Just as Jesus came to us through His Blessed Mother, we will go to Him through her.

Why not give the First Five Saturdays Devotion a try beginning in January as a good New Year's resolution in your prayer life? Requirements to fulfill the First Saturday Devotion:

- 1. Go to Confession (may be 8 days or more before, or eight days more after if you are in a state of grace)
- 2. Receive Holy Communion in a state of grace
- 3. Pray five decades of the Rosary, including the Fatima prayer following every "Glory be" (Oh my Jesus...)
- 4. Keep Our Lady company for 15 minutes while meditating on one or more of the mysteries of the Rosary (this meditation is in addition to the recitation of the Rosary).




