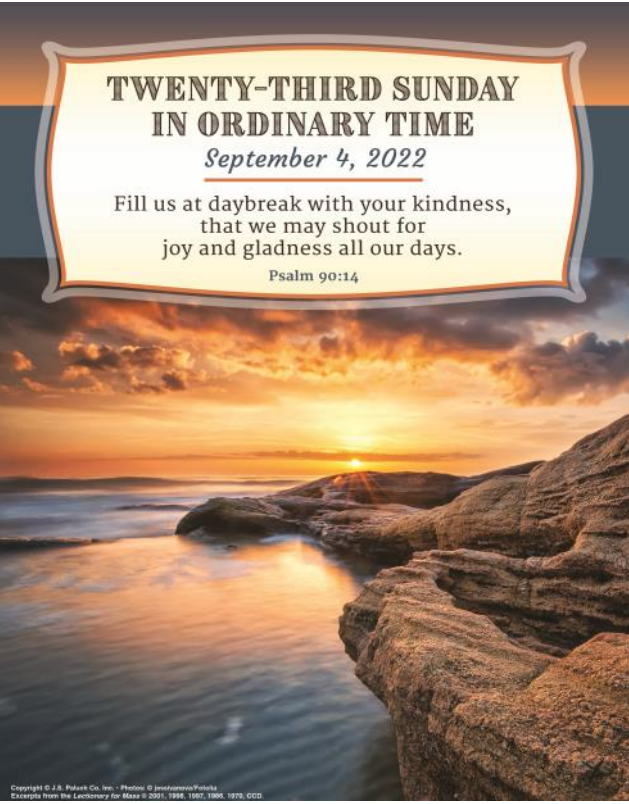

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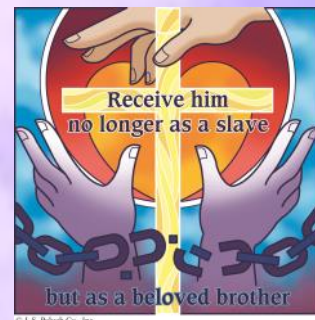

LIMITS

Today's readings continue the theme of humility explored last Sunday. All three readings today encourage us to admit that we have limits, and God has none. The poignant poetry of Wisdom resonates with all of us who have ever struggled for peace in situations we cannot control: "For the corruptible body burdens the soul and the earthen shelter weighs down the mind that has many concerns." Saint Paul recognizes his own limitations, both physically (he is in prison) and spiritually: he cannot compel his friend to obey his wishes; he can only propose his request and respect Philemon's free will. In the Gospel, Jesus reminds us that God alone can complete the good we wish to do in the world. While we thank God for the gifts we receive—and the families we love—we acknowledge that they are temporary, and humbly cling to God.



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LOS LÍMITES

Las lecturas de hoy continúan con el tema de la humildad que se exploró el domingo pasado.



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Las tres lecturas de hoy nos animan a admitir que tenemos límites, y que Dios no tiene ninguno. La conmovedora poesía del libro de la Sabiduría resuena en todos los que alguna vez luchamos por la paz en situaciones que no podemos controlar: "porque un cuerpo corruptible hace pesada el alma y el barro de que estamos hechos entorpece el entendimiento". San Pablo reconoce sus propias limitaciones, tanto física (está en prisión) y espiritualmente: él no puede obligar a su amigo a obedecer sus deseos; él solamente puede proponer su petición y respetar el libre albedrío de Filemón. En el Evangelio, Jesús nos recuerda que sólo Dios puede completar el bien que deseamos hacer en el mundo. Mientras agradecemos a Dios por los dones que recibimos, y las familias que amamos, reconozcamos que son temporales y que humildemente nos mantengamos cerca de Dios.

LABOR DAY

In 1894 President Grover Cleveland officially proclaimed the first Monday in September a day to honor all workers in the United States. Three years earlier, in 1891, Pope Leo XIII wrote an encyclical entitled *Rerum Novarum*, Latin for "new things." The new things Pope Leo wrote about were the rights and dignity and respect that should be given to all workers. Monday, September 5, the United States will celebrate Labor Day, a day that honors workers and remembers those who fought for laws that ensured that workers are treated with dignity and respect.

As Christians we believe that all honest work is good and holy, a way that we join God in the work of creation. Work is a chance for us to take the gifts and talents God has given us and use them for the good of our families and others. People work in many different ways. Some work with their hands to make things we need like clothes, food, and furniture. Others make things that are beautiful for us to enjoy—painters, jewelers, writers, poets, and composers of music. Still others do work that keeps us safe—road repairers, police and firefighters, and garbage collectors. Doctors, teachers, nurses, and counselors give their lives to helping others. Many people work at home, raising children, preparing meals, washing clothes, and keeping the family's home. On Labor Day we celebrate all people who work.

St. Joseph is the patron saint of workers. Joseph worked as a carpenter, a craftsman, and probably taught Jesus to work right alongside him. He is a good model of how our work helps others and gives praise to God. On this Labor Day, say a prayer for all the workers you know.

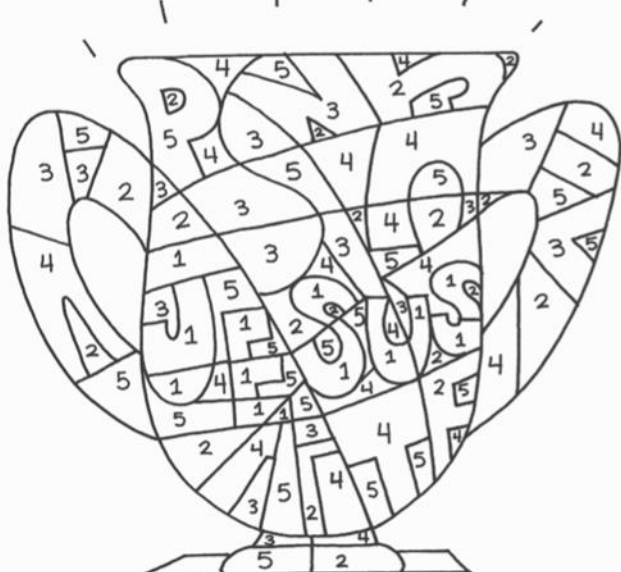

September 10th & 11th, 2022

(Saturday & Sunday)

A group from the Holy Land (Bethlehem & Jerusalem) will be selling religious articles after the Masses to support the Catholic Christian minorities in Bethlehem. As a tradition, many of the Catholic families in the Holy Land work in small workshops to produce religious articles from olive wood.

These articles represent the Christian art of the Holy Land. In the past, they used to sell their artwork to pilgrims who visited the Holy Land. However, these days they are facing an economic hardship, as there are no tourists visiting the Holy Land due to the pandemic. Many of the Catholic families immigrated and left the Holy Land. The percentage of Christians in the Holy Land has dropped from 20% to less than 1%. Therefore, if this hardship continues as it is now, we believe that in a few years, there will be no Catholics in Bethlehem or Jerusalem.

The struggle to preserve the Catholic identity of the birthplace of our savior; Jesus Christ is a serious concern for Catholics around the world. Sales will be used to help and support the Catholics in the Holy Land and to encourage them not to immigrate.

Artesanías en Madera de Olivo

10 y 11 de Septiembre de 2022

(Sábado y Domingo)

Un grupo de Tierra Santa (Belén y Jerusalén) venderá artículos religiosos después de las Misas para apoyar a las minorías cristianas católicas en Belén. Como tradición, muchas de las familias católicas de la Tierra Santa trabajan en pequeños talleres para producir artículos religiosos a partir de madera de olivo.

Estos artículos representan el arte cristiano de Tierra Santa. En el pasado, solían vender sus obras de arte a los peregrinos que visitaban Tierra Santa. Sin embargo, en estos días se enfrentan a dificultades económicas, ya que no hay turistas que visiten Tierra Santa debido a la pandemia. Muchas de las familias católicas emigraron y abandonaron Tierra Santa. El porcentaje de cristianos en Tierra Santa ha bajado del 20% a menos del 1%. Por lo tanto, si esta dificultad continúa como ahora, creemos que en unos años, no habrá católicos en Belén o Jerusalén.

La lucha por preservar la identidad católica del lugar de nacimiento de nuestro salvador; Jesucristo es una preocupación seria para los católicos de todo el mundo. Las ventas se utilizarán para ayudar y apoyar a los católicos en Tierra Santa y alentarlos a no emigrar.
