### **SEEDS TUITION ASSISTANCE:**

Families registered in one of our Catholic schools are eligible to apply for a SEEDS Scholarship.

- A family is to complete the application process by March 5<sup>th</sup>, for the following school year.
- There is a \$40 per family application fee, which is paid by the family.
- An application is considered complete and eligible for consideration when all the required documentation has been filed and verified by March 5th. Please note it can take several weeks to verify information, so it is important to start well in advance of March 5th.
- Applications which are incomplete on March 16th will not be eligible for a scholarship.
