Dear Parishioners.

As I mentioned in last week's bulletin, I am highlighting the three traditional pillars of Lent: prayer, fasting, and abstinence. Let's take another look at prayer. In last week's Gospel from Mark we read:

The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert, and he remained in the desert for forty days, tempted by Satan. He was among wild beasts, and the angels ministered to him.

Jesus spent time in the wilderness in prayerful contemplation and preparation, knowing that His life would be spent serving and ultimately dying for our sake. Lent is our desert experience—what better time to increase our prayer life? In addition to attending daily Mass and adoration, here are some other suggestions for Lent:

- · Pray a daily decade of the Rosary
- Do a daily examination of conscience
- Read and reflect on the daily Mass readings
- Spend five minutes in silence every day, asking the Lord, "What do you want from me this Lent?"

I also want to inform you of some exciting news about the bronze doors and the baptistry. The re-installation of the bronze doors will be taking place over the next few weeks (hopefully completed by Easter). We will also be doing some work to beautify the baptistry. With the help of a private donor, the floor will be tiled, and some new lighting and painted murals will be installed. Thank you for your patience and support during this process.

The Latin Mass Parts

During Lent at the Cathedral, we chant the Latin Mass parts which can be found in the Worship Aid in the pews.

ENGLISH:

Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of hosts Heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

LATIN:

Sanctus, Sanctus, Sanctus Dóminus Deus Sábaoth. Pleni sunt caeli et terra glória tua. Hosánna in excélsis. Benedíctus qui venit in nómine Dómini. Hosánna in excélsis.

ENGLISH:

Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us. Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us. Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, grant us peace.

LATIN:

Agnus Dei, qui tollis peccáta mundi: miserére nobis. Agnus Dei, qui tollis peccáta mundi: miserére nobis. Agnus Dei, qui tollis peccáta mundi: dona nobis pacem.

If you are unfamiliar with the Latin Mass parts, here are some helpful tips to remember.

PRONUNCIATION: When singing the *Agnus Dei* (Lamb of God), keep in mind that "gn" together make a "ny" sound, so *Agnus* is pronounced "Ah-nyus" not "Agnes." Otherwise, the vowels are pronounced "ah, eh, ee, oh, oo" and the consonants as you would expect. Bonus points if you can do a flipped 'r' instead of an American 'r'! The other Latin chant we sing is *Sanctus*, *Sanctus*, *Sanctus* (Holy, Holy, Holy). *Sabaoth* and *Hosanna* are actually Hebrew words that have found their way into Catholic liturgies (along with Amen and Alleluia). Additionally, please note that when "c" is followed by "e," "i," or "ae," it becomes the "ch" sound instead of the "k" sound. At the end of the *Agnus Dei*, we pronounce the word "pacem" as "pa-chem," not "pakem," and in the *Sanctus* we pronounce "caeli" as "chaeli," not "kaylee."

MEANING: Sanctus means holy, and we have a lot of English derivatives (sanctify, sanctity, saint). Dominus means Lord, and we have words like dominion, dominate, domain, etc. Caeli means the heavens, terra means the earth, and we have words like celestial, terrain, territory, even extraterrestrial (literally from outside of earth). Benedictus means blessed (Benediction at the end of a period of Adoration literally means "blessing").

WHY LATIN? In singing in Latin, the liturgical language of our Rite, we are celebrating our unity with the Church across the world and across the ages.

Fasting & Abstinence During Lent

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of both fasting and abstinence. All Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence.*

- Fasting: Catholics who are ages 18 to 59 are obliged to fast. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal.
- Abstinence: Catholics from age 14 onwards are bound to abstain from consuming meat.

*Exceptions include those who are physically and mentally ill (including chronic illnesses like diabetes) as well as pregnant and nursing women. The Church teaches that common sense should prevail so that a person does not further jeopardize their health because of the fasting requirements.
