## CATHEDRAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

**Lenten Confession Times** - In addition to our regular confession times, the Cathedral will have confessions on Tuesday, March 19, from 7:30 PM to 8:30 PM. Additionally, the Sacrament of Confession will be offered on Tuesday, March 26 at the Our Lady of Victory Chapel on the campus of St. Mary's Central High School in north Bismarck. Beginning at 6:30 PM, 12 area priests will be available for confession. The event is open to the public. Please use the main chapel entrance, which is located in the front courtyard of the school.

**Shadow-Style Stations of the Cross** - On Friday, March 22, Cathedral School students will be hosting the Stations of the Cross at 7:00 PM in the main body of the church. They will be re-enacting the Stations of the Cross in a shadow-style presentation. We will also have Children's Stations of the Cross that Friday at 4:00 PM. Everyone is welcome.

**Palm Sunday Vigil Mass** - Those arriving for the 5:00 PM Palm Sunday Vigil Mass on Saturday, March 23 are invited to take a palm branch and Holy Week Missal in the gathering space and be seated in the church as normal. A representative group of new Catholics, new parishioners, and parish groups will join Bishop Kagan in a Palm Sunday procession at the beginning of Mass. Your palms will be blessed, along with the palms in the gathering space.

- 2. Obedience and discernment.** It opens us up and allows us to let God and the Church tell us what is best for us.
- 3. Worship and sacrifice.** Fasting is a sacrifice oriented towards worship of God and not ourselves.
- 4. To be co-redeemers with Jesus.** As it is a sacrifice, we participate in the Cross of Jesus for the salvation of the world.

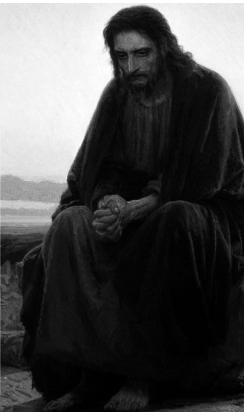

## Fasting & Abstinence During Lent

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of both fasting and abstinence. All Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence.\*

- Fasting: Catholics who are ages 18 to 59 are obliged to fast. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal.
- Abstinence: Catholics from age 14 onwards are bound to abstain from consuming meat.

*\*Exceptions include those who are physically and mentally ill (including chronic illnesses like diabetes) as well as pregnant and nursing women. The Church teaches that common sense should prevail so that a person does not further jeopardize their health because of the fasting requirements.*
