<u>Baptism</u>: Parents must attend a Baptism Preparation Class before Baptism and it is recommended in advance of the child's birth. Contact the Parish Office.


<u>Marriage</u>: Couples should contact the Parish Office at least a year before the date of the wedding and before any other plans are made.
