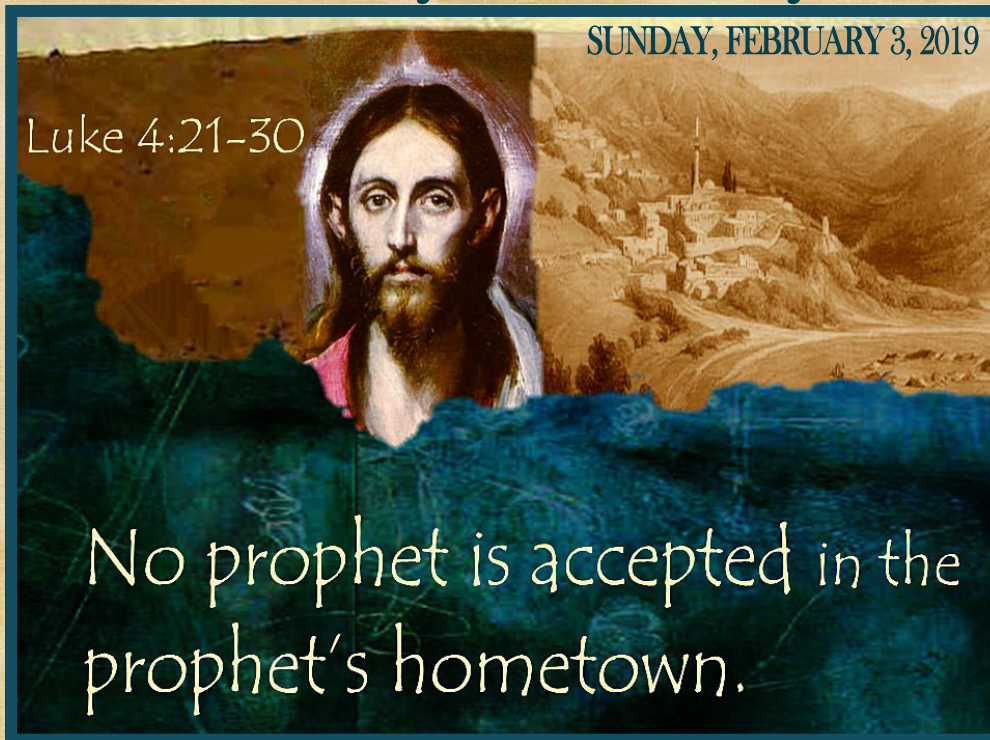

Every year on **February 3** the church honors **St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr**. The story of St. Blaise relays to us how he saved a young child who was choking because of a fish bone lodged in his throat. St. Blaise prayed over the child and the bone was miraculously dislodged, and his life was saved. For this reason, each year on the feast day of St. Blaise, a special blessing is bestowed on anyone who would like to receive it. Using two candles in the form a cross, held to the throat of the recipient, the blessing is given.

This weekend, after all masses, the throat blessing, with two crossed candles, will be bestowed on anyone wishing to receive it. The words of the blessing are as follows:

Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God protect you from all diseases of the throat, and from every other illness, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

It's **CSA** time again! We have been informed by the diocese that the information about the 2019 CSA appeal has been mailed to our parishioners. Hopefully, you received it and that you had a chance to read over the material.

It took us until the last weekend of 2018 to reach last year's goal, but we were able to do it thanks to the generosity of all our parishioners. Our new goal has been assessed, and we are gearing up to begin this year's annual appeal. The Diocese of Las Vegas determines the CSA goal for each parish. It is based on size and annual income of each parish, and then divided among the 32 parishes within the diocese. The 2019 CSA goal for the entire Diocese of Las Vegas is \$2,700,00.00. The assessed portion of this amount for Our Lady of Las Vegas Parish this year has been determined as **\$114,654.00**.

When making a contribution to the CSA, where exactly does your contribution go and whom does it benefit? That's a very good question. Most people, by nature, have generous hearts and are very willing to help other people who are in need. So, in order to give you a better idea of what the CSA funds are used for, the Diocese of Las Vegas has put together a break down of all CSA contributions:

- **51%** of the CSA budget goes towards the promotion of vocations and helping the formation of new priests. While our seminarians must bear most of the financial burden, your CSA contributions help to make that burden a little lighter. It goes towards the on-going education of priests and helping to fund the retirement of elderly priests.
- **18%** goes towards Faith Formation, Youth Ministry and Hispanic Catechesis.
- **10%** goes towards Catholic campus ministry at UNLV.
- **15%** goes towards pastoral outreach in the diocese including Catholic Charities and St. Therese Center, the televised Mass on Sunday, and the diocesan website services.
- **6%** goes towards the Department of Catholic Education.

Every parish family should have received a letter from the diocese regarding the 2019 CSA goal. If you haven't yet received it, you should be receiving it soon. Each parish household is asked to make a donation, either through a one-time offering or a pledged offering that can be made over a series of monthly payments throughout the year. **If you are not making a pledge**, another option is to donate through the **green CSA envelopes** in your monthly parish envelope packet. Also, **second collections** will be taken up at mass for CSA on various Sundays over the course of the year. You can always place a donation in the **"CSA BOX"** in the vestibule of the church.

Please prayerfully consider your CSA donation for 2019. If every registered family donated at least **\$100**, we would easily make our goal. Any amount collected over and above our goal will be returned to the parish. Your donation will help in the Diocesan Church extended ministry and will help us meet our parish goal. Thank you so much for our kind and generous consideration.

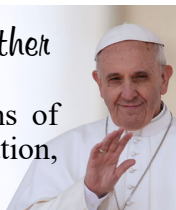

AN ONGOING MISSION

In his hometown synagogue, Jesus' neighbors are amazed by his words. Nevertheless, they remind each other, "Is this not Joseph's son?"

Surely the people know who he is. The carpenter's son. The young man who had learned in this very synagogue. The boy down the street.

Conflict arises as Jesus begins to define himself in a new way. When he compares himself to the ancient prophets Elijah and Elisha the tensions grow. The tensions multiply when Jesus begins to tell of a new mission for God's people: the good news of the scriptures is intended for all.

In his famous passage from the First Letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul reminds us of the eternal nature of love. Love does not come to an end. In today's readings, we are reminded that, like love, Jesus' mission cannot be contained. Jesus slips through the crowd of persecutors and moves on to new challenges. We are called to this same perseverance in the name of love.

Parish Services

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: If you are in need of anointing, even if you are homebound or hospitalized, contact the parish office at 802-2300. *In an emergency situation when the office is closed, you will be directed to the emergency extension.*

BAPTISMS: Baptisms are usually held on the second and fourth Saturday of each month. Parents must be registered, active parishioners at a parish for at least 3 months. Parents and Godparents must attend a baptism class (OLLV's class is usually the second Thursday of each month). Once these requirements are met, you may then make an appointment with our Sacramental Administrator at 802-2300.

HOLY COMMUNION TO THE HOMEBOUND: If you are homebound or in a hospital and would like to receive holy communion, please contact the parish office 802-2300.
