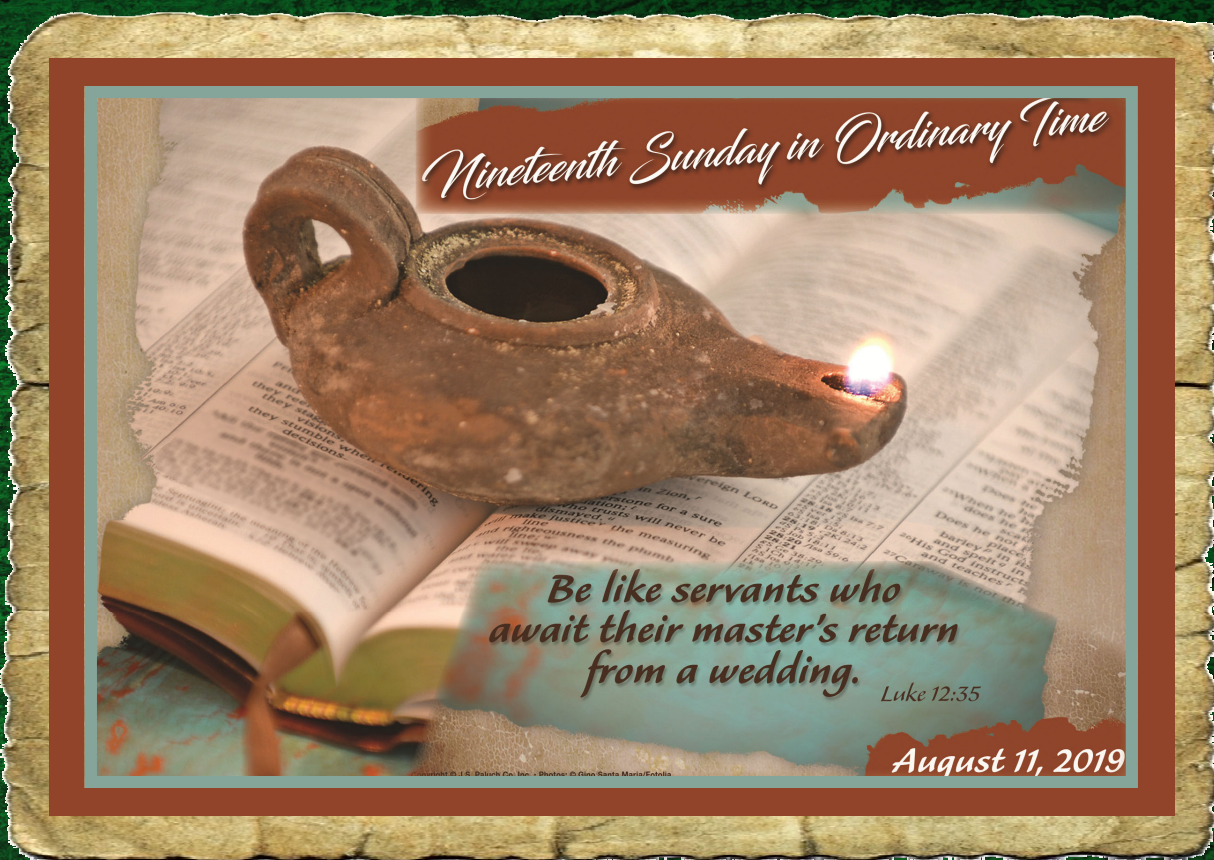

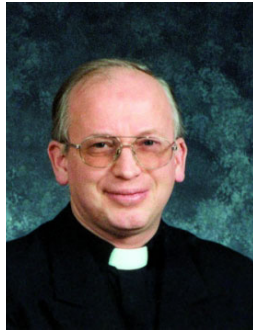

Fr. Julian Kaczówka

(pronounced: Kah-choof-kah)

Fr. Julian, a priest for the Society of Christ, was born in Tarnów, Poland. Fr. Julian has two married sisters and a brother who still live in Poland. Father Julian was ordained to the priesthood in 1988 in Poznań, Poland and came to the United States in 1991.

After brief stays in Sterling Heights, Michigan and Toronto Canada, Fr. Julian received his first assignment in Windsor, Ontario, Canada and later went to Calgary, Alberta, Canada. In 1996, he was sent to Sacred Heart Monastery in Milwaukee, Wisconsin for English language studies. During his time at Sacred Heart, he assisted on the weekends at Holy Trinity Church in Chicago.

Following completion of his studies at Sacred Heart, he was sent to St. Florian Church in Hamtramck, Michigan. After a year there, he again returned to Canada in Kingston, Ontario where he worked with the Polish Apostolate and Providence Manor Nursing Home.

From Kingston, Fr. Julian was transferred to Five Holy Martyrs, in Chicago, where he served for two years with Fr. Gerry before his assignment as Pastor of Nativity Church in San Francisco for three years.

His last assignment, before coming to Our Lady of Las Vegas, was as Associate Pastor of Holy Cross in Joliet, Illinois for 11 years.

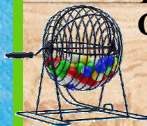

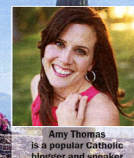

Eligibility for Enrollment:

- Copy of your child's **Birth Certificate**

- Children cannot be enrolled without these documents - NO EXCEPTIONS
- Only parents or legal guardians can enroll children in the program
