

At the end of the day on Tuesday, June 30, Mrs. Phyllis Joyce, who has been principal of Our Lady of Las Vegas School since 2007, closed her office door, walked outside of the school building, and officially began her retirement. We are very grateful for Mrs. Joyce's leadership over the past 13 years, and we especially thank her for expertise in continuing to manage the school during the unexpected shutdown in March, which lasted through the end of the school year. We wish her well in her retirement.

Thankfully, the school will be reopening for the new school year. But in order for that to happen, it was necessary to find a new principal who will be able to lead our school forward. Fortunately, we have found that person. We are pleased to welcome **Mrs. Marisa Bello** as the new Principal to Our Lady of Las Vegas School.

Marisa brings a wealth of experience to Our Lady of Las Vegas, having served the Diocese of Las Vegas for 12 years. Marisa began her career at Bishop Gorman High School where she served as a teacher and also as the school's Math Department Chair. Her experience led her to the position of principal at St. Francis de Sales School, followed by two years of leadership at Cristo Rey St. Viator, where she served as the school's founding principal.

Mrs. Bello is a graduate of the University of Nevada, Reno, and holds a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from the University of Cincinnati. Her Catholic leadership experience at the elementary, middle school, and high school levels, as well as the accreditation process, will ensure the continued success of our academic programs, faith formation, and school policies. For the past two years, Mrs. Bello has been blessed to be a member of the Our Lady of Las Vegas school community as a parent with children in First Grade and Third Grade. She is excited to be at Our Lady of Las Vegas in this new capacity.

Reopening the school in the midst of the Covid pandemic, with all of its restrictions, mandates, and precautions set forth by the State of Nevada and the Diocese of Las Vegas, is not a simple task. Marisa, together with the entire staff, are working diligently to have everything set in place so that the school can open safely on Monday August 17.

The school shut down also caused the cancellation of 8th grade graduation ceremonies, First Communion and Confirmation. These cancellations have caused much disappointment for the children and their families.

We are pleased that we have begun letting the children who were preparing for First Communion to finally make their First Communion. The first group of children from our parish Religious Education program made their First Communion on Saturday, August 1. The second group will be on Saturday August 8. The children from the second grade class of Our Lady will make their First Communion on Saturday, August 15 and August 22 respectively. Each group is limited so that no more than 50 people will be in attendance at one time.

Please keep these children in your prayers as they come into communion with Jesus for the first time.

SAINT JOHN MARY VIANNEY (1786-1859) August 4

A busy pastor jokingly suggests the secret of John Vianney's holiness: "He died seventeen years before telephones!" Call they didn't, but visit they did, keeping Vianney eighteen hours a day in the confessional. Stories abound of reading hearts and exorcisms, but Vianney's first miracle

was getting ordained. Difficulty with studies delayed him, prompting the rector's apology to the bishop, "So far to ordain just one, especially *this* one!" The bishop, who could not know he was ordaining the future patron saint of parish priests, replied, "No burden to ordain one good priest!" In Ars, only an elderly handful attended Mass, "praying," one told Vianney, "for a priest with brains." But he stayed forty-two years, fulfilling the promise he made the day he arrived. In a sculpture just outside the village Vianney points skyward: "Show me the way to Ars," he tells a boy, "and I'll show you the way to heaven." To someone who feared there was no heaven beyond the grave, Vianney smiled, "My child, it would have been heaven enough to have lived as Jesus' disciple on earth." —Peter Scagnelli, Copyright © J. S.
