Holy Week begins this Sunday with our observance of **Palm Sunday**. This is the most sacred time of the year for Christians. During this week our focus is on the most important events in the earthly life of Jesus: His suffering, death and resurrection; also known as the **Paschal Mystery**.

Palm Sunday mass has two parts. It begins with the solemn memorial of Jesus' last days on earth and the events that lead up to his death and resurrection. The liturgy of Palm Sunday begins with the blessing of palm branches and the reading of the Gospel narrative of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Palm Sunday is also known as **Passion Sunday** because, during this mass, we are taken to the very dark day of Jesus' passion and death. The lengthy Gospel narrative of the Passion of Jesus is read, this year, from the Gospel according to St. Luke.

Lent actually comes to an end this week on Holy Thursday. On the evening of Holy Thursday, the short, three-day liturgical season called the **Easter Triduum** begins. The Easter Triduum encompasses the events of the Last Supper on Holy Thursday evening, the crucifixion and death of Jesus on Good Friday, the burial of Jesus, and finally the resurrection on Easter Sunday.

The **Holy Thursday** evening Mass of the Lord's Supper remembers the last meal Jesus shared with his Apostles. It recalls the institution of the Sacraments of the **Eucharist** and **Holy Orders**. The holy oils that were consecrated by the bishop at the Chrism Mass are presented for sacramental use in the parish, which will be used throughout the year. The liturgy of the washing of feet occurs to remember how Jesus washed the feet of His Apostles and prepared them for priestly service. At the end of Mass, the Eucharist, the Real Presence of Jesus, is taken to the Altar of Repose and all the ornaments and furnishings in the sanctuary are taken away. The sanctuary is left bare as a reminder that Jesus was taken away into custody and will face his condemnation and crucifixion the next day.

Good Friday is the somber memorial of Jesus' horrific crucifixion and death on the cross. It is a day of fasting and penance. It is a day for personal reflection and examination of conscience. The church is bare on Good Friday. Mass is not celebrated this day. Instead, the liturgy of Good Friday is celebrated. **This is not a mass.** The Good Friday liturgy includes the reading of the Passion of Jesus according to St. John, the solemn General Intercessions of the Church, the veneration of the cross by all the faithful, and the reception of Holy Communion. The Eucharist we receive at this liturgy was consecrated on Holy Thursday at the evening mass of the Lord's Supper. At the end of the Good Friday liturgy, the congregation departs in reverent silence, reflecting on the death of the Lord.

Holy Saturday is the day that the Church somberly waits at the tomb of the Lord. It is tradition that baskets of food items that will be eaten for breakfast on Easter Sunday are blessed on this day. **Food blessings** will be at **11:00am in English**, and **12:00pm and 1:00pm in Polish**.

The **Easter Vigil**, the most solemn celebration of liturgy, begins at dusk at 7:30pm on **Holy Saturday**. It is the powerful celebration of the resurrection of Jesus. The liturgy begins with the blessing of new fire, which reminds us that Christ is the Light of the World. Several selected passages from the Old Testament are read reminding us of God's development of His covenant with His people throughout history. Water is blessed and new Christians are baptized into the Catholic faith. The newly baptized, and baptized Christians who have been preparing through the RCIA program, will complete the process of initiation into the Catholic Church by receiving the sacraments of the Eucharist and Confirmation. Easter Sunday masses will follow the regular Sunday Schedule.

The nine day novena to the Divine Mercy begins on Good Friday, and concludes on the Sunday after Easter. The entire schedule of the Divine Mercy Novena and Holy Week can be found in the bulletin and on our parish social media sites.

NEWS AROUND the DIOCESE & CHURCH UNIVERSAL



Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

On Good Friday, April 15, 2022, our Diocese will take up the national collection for the Holy Land.

The Collection for the Holy Land, in the words of Pope Saint Paul VI, is “not only for the Holy Places but above all for those pastoral, charitable, educational, and social works which the Church supports in the Holy Land for the welfare of their Christian brethren and of the local communities.”

This Collection brings an indispensable support to the Christian minority of the Holy Land. The State of Israel and Palestine have a population of 10 million people; the 180,000 Christian inhabitants represent less than 2% of this population. To check the exodus from the Holy Land of Christians whose lives are rendered difficult, the Franciscan Custody implements numerous initiatives. In addition to guarding the shrines, the Good Friday Annual Collection allows these living stones to inhabit the Holy Places and bear witness to the Resurrection of Christ.

Shrines in Bethlehem, Nazareth, Jerusalem and many other locations welcome Christian pilgrims regularly throughout the year with Christian generosity and hospitality. Further, the Church in the Holy Land provides housing and food for the poor.

Please be generous in your support of this collection. Holy Land Christians, along with the clergy and religious working there, greatly depend on our generosity.

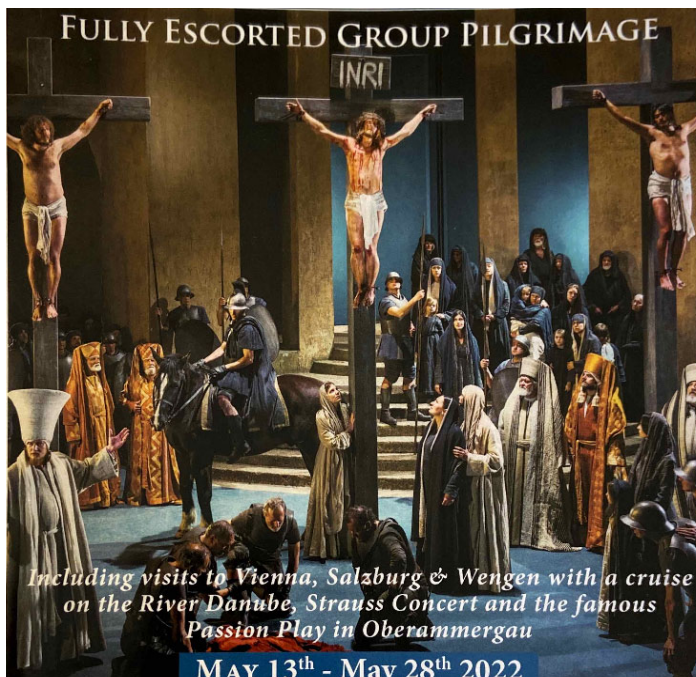
On March 6, European Union consular corps in Los Angeles took part in the special event to show solidarity with Ukraine. Thank you for a very warm welcome at the Ukrainian Cultural Center in Los Angeles.

From the beginning of the war, Poland admitted over 1 million refugees from the territory of Ukraine. The new law was introduced to allow for 18 months of legal stay for all refugees regardless the nationality, origin, and citizenship. They will have immediate access to the labor market as well as to public health, and education.

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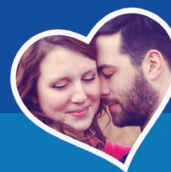
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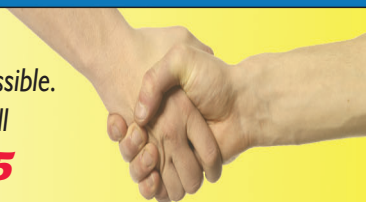
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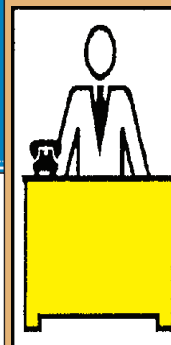
