This **Second Sunday of Easter** is also known as **Divine Mercy Sunday**. It was established as such by Jesus himself through a lowly and humble Polish nun, **St. Sister Faustina Kowalska**, about a century ago. Through a series of Divine revelations, Sister Faustina, who was the first canonized saint of the new millennium by **St. Pope John Paul II**, was given the message to tell the world about the message of God's Mercy... **Divine Mercy**... which flows from God's incredible and powerful love for us. No one who ever approaches our merciful God will ever be rejected. The key is to have faith and to trust. **"Jesus, I trust in You"** are the words inscribed beneath the image of Jesus, who has His arm held out in blessing and whose heart emits the red and white rays. You can never go wrong in trusting Him. Have faith, believe, and trust in Him!

On the day of Sister Faustina's canonization, April 30, 2000, Pope John Paul II declared that the Second Sunday of Easter would be observed by the Universal Church as Divine Mercy Sunday. This is in response to the request of Jesus himself to Sister Faustina that this feast be observed on this day.

Mercy is an incredible gift. It is a great act of compassion and clemency towards a person who otherwise deserves to face judgment and punishment for wrongdoings, crimes and sins. Everyone of us is a sinner. We are all deserving of judgment and punishment. But God offers us clemency and forgiveness. To be sure, we are undeserving, but God offers us forgiveness because of his great love. How truly grateful we are and should be.

In the Gospel this Sunday, Jesus appears to his disciples, who abandoned him, and He offers them peace, forgiveness, and reconciliation. Jesus also imparts on his disciples the authority to extend forgiveness to all his people. This is the institution of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Through his passion, death and resurrection, Jesus has reconciled the world to the Father. We need never be afraid, only humble, and approach the Lord with remorse and sorrow for our sins. Jesus offers us mercy. In God's presence, we stand forgiven.

I would like to take the opportunity this weekend to express **my sincerest thanks** to everyone for making the observance of Holy Week and the celebration of Easter so beautiful and special.

The liturgies of Holy Week and the Easter Triduum are beautiful and meaningful, but, as with anything special, they require a lot of preparation and coordination. A lot goes on behind the scenes. From decorating the church, to preparing liturgies, to coordinating the participants, altar servers and various ministers, to preparing the music; all is necessary to assure that the liturgies run smoothly so as to make them as meaningful as possible. Thank goodness that we have dedicated people on our staff and many volunteers, who are always ready to pitch in, participate and help. For this help I am sincerely grateful.

Fr. Julian and I would like to thank everyone for remembering us at Easter time with your good wishes, cards, gifts, baked goods and food. We are truly grateful for your generosity and we thank you for taking the time to think about us. May God bless you for your goodness.

As you know, the Easter Masses are among the most highly attended liturgies all year. As we arise from the Covid restrictions, it was great to see the church filled with so many people again. Our coming together as a community of believers is important for our own faith journey as well as each other's. The story of Jesus is important for us to hear, and we need to keep coming back to keep it alive in our hearts and in our lives. It is a story to hear, to know, to believe and to live!

The tomb is empty! He is risen... and, as He said, will be with us always until the end of time!

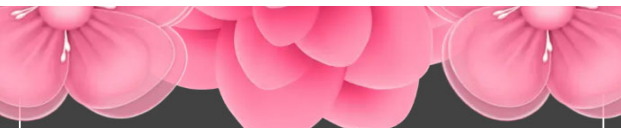

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

One of the seven sacraments, also known as the "sacrament of the dying," administered by a priest to a baptized person who begins to be in danger of death because of illness or old age, through prayer and the anointing of the body with the oil of the sick. The proper effects of the sacrament include a special grace of healing and comfort to the Christian who is suffering the infirmities of serious illness or old age, and the forgiving of the person's sins.

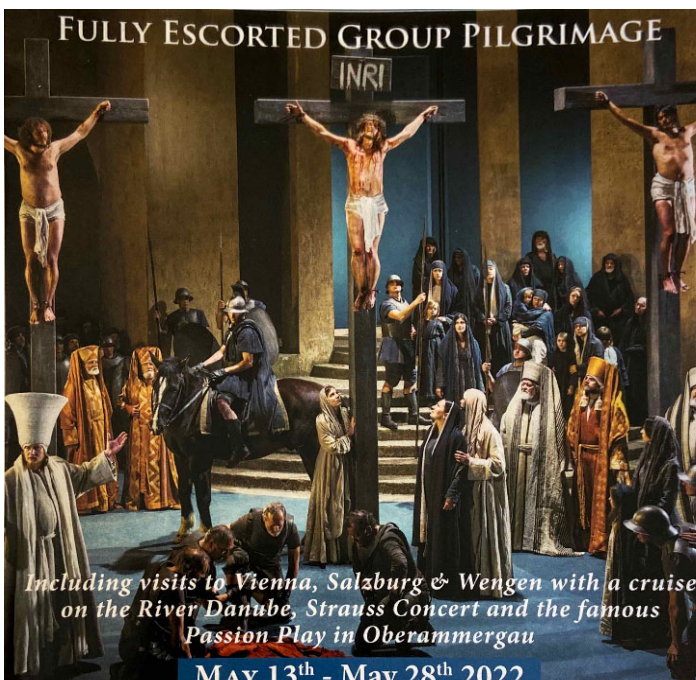

Consulate General of the Republic of Poland in Los Angeles

We are receiving an enormous number of inquiries regarding the possibility of helping refugees from Ukraine who seek in Poland refuge from the unprovoked aggression of the Russian Federation. Thank you for every kind word and willingness to help. The Polish government has launched an official website to coordinate humanitarian relief. It is the first place of information for people that want to aid the humanitarian relief at the Polish-Ukrainian border.

On March 6, European Union consular corps in Los Angeles took part in the special event to show solidarity with Ukraine. Thank you for a very warm welcome at the Ukrainian Cultural Center in Los Angeles.

From the beginning of the war, Poland admitted over 1 million refugees from the territory of Ukraine. The new law was introduced to allow for 18 months of legal stay for all refugees regardless the nationality, origin, and citizenship. They will have immediate access to the labor market as well as to public health, and education.

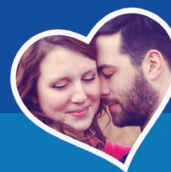
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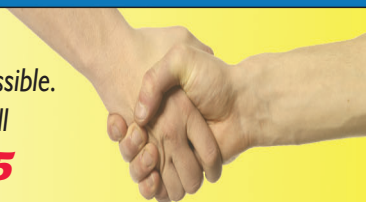
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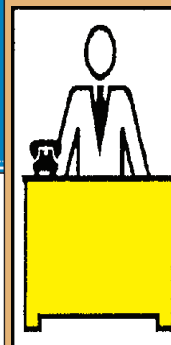
