

We are now into the month of **May**. Without a doubt May is one of the most beautiful months of the year. It's the month that ushers in the warmth of springtime and the blooming of flowers and trees. It is in this lovely setting of warmth and flowers that the Church honors the Blessed Mother.

Special devotion to the Blessed Mother in May has been a sacred tradition, both in Church and in Catholic households. This Christian custom of dedicating the month of May to the Blessed Virgin extends back to the latter part of the 13th century.

Throughout the Church's history, Popes have recommended honoring Mary during the month of May. In his great Encyclical on the Sacred Liturgy, *Mediator Dei*, (The Mediator of God) Pope Pius XII characterized devotion to Mary as being of great piety and dignity. Pope Paul VI wrote a short encyclical in 1965 stating that May devotions are a means of prayer for peace. He urged the faithful to make use of this practice by which the Blessed Virgin Mary is honored and the Christian people are enriched with spiritual gifts. In May of 2002, Pope John Paul II, who had deep devotion to Mary, said, "Today we begin the month dedicated to Our Lady, a favorite of popular Marian devotion." In accord with a long-standing tradition of devotion, parishes and families continue to make the month of May a **Marian** month, with prayer to Mary, asking for her loving and powerful intercession.

Jesus desired that his mother be our mother and the Mother of the Church. On the cross, Jesus gave Mary to us through the Apostle John as his last will and testament. Mary is the example, guide and inspiration of everyone who seeks to be a servant of God and mankind, because she is the obedient agent of the promptings of the Holy Spirit.

In our observance of this Marian month we must also take into account the liturgical season that accompanies it. A great portion of the fifty days of the Easter season falls in May. Our prayers in honor of Mary also emphasize her participation in the Passion, Death and Resurrection of her Son. Also, Mary's presence at Pentecost brings her into the beginnings of the apostolic mission of the Church. Mary is a true apostle of her Son.

The foremost Marian devotion in May is the **Litany of Loreto.** During May, in many places around the world, people gather together every evening in the presence of an image of the Blessed Virgin Mary to sing or recite the words of the litany. When I was in the seminary in Poland, each evening in May, we would gather at the grotto of the Blessed Mother in our seminary garden, and sing the litany together. The Litany of Loreto, one of many Marian litanies, was composed during the Middle Ages. The Litany of Loreto was wholeheartedly recommended by Pope Clement VII and approved by Pope Sixtus V in 1587, which made it one of the most widely used prayers in honor of the Blessed Mother throughout the world.

The many titles of Mary in the Litany are invocations exalting Mary's privileges, her holiness of life, her amiability and power, her motherly spirit and queenly majesty. Reflection on these titles of Mary in the litany unfolds before us a magnificent picture of Mary, our Queen and Mother.

Another traditional practice is the crowning of the image of the Blessed Mother with a floral crown, recognizing Mary as our Mother and Queen. The children of our school will celebrate the annual May crowning at the school mass on Friday, May 9.

Pray for us, O holy Mother of God; that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ. Amen

Please keep in your prayers the young people of our parish who will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation on Tuesday, May 6 and the Religious Education First Communion on Saturday, May 10.







NEWS AROUND the DIOCESE & CHURCH UNIVERSAL



The Vatican announced Monday that the canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis has been postponed following the death of Pope Francis.

"Following the death of Supreme Pontiff Francis, notice is hereby given that the Eucharistic celebration and Rite of Canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis, scheduled for April 27, 2025, II Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy, on the occasion of the Jubilee of Adolescents, is suspended," the Holy See Press Office said in a statement on April 21. The Vatican has not yet given an alternative date when the canonization could take place.

Acutis, who died of leukemia in 2006 at age 15, is known for his devotion to the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Born in 1991 in London and raised in Milan, he is the first millennial to be beatified by the Church.

Shortly after his first Communion at the age of 7, Carlo told his mother: "To always be united to Jesus: This is my life plan." To accomplish this, Carlo sought to attend daily Mass as often as possible at the parish church across the street from his elementary school in Milan.

Carlo called the Eucharist "my highway to heaven," and he did all in his power to make this presence known. His witness inspired his own parents to return to practicing the Catholic faith and his Hindu au pair to convert and be baptized.

Carlo was a tech-savvy kid who loved computers, animals, and video games. His spiritual director has recalled that Carlo was convinced that the evidence of Eucharistic miracles could be persuasive in helping people to realize that Jesus is present at every Mass.

Over the course of two and a half years, Carlo worked with his family to put together an exhibition on Eucharistic miracles that premiered in 2005 during the Year of the Eucharist proclaimed by Pope John Paul II and has since gone on to be displayed at thousands of parishes on five continents.

Many of Carlo's classmates, friends, and family members have testified how he brought them closer to God. They remember Carlo as a very open person who was not shy to speak with his classmates and anyone he met about the things that he loved: the Mass, the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, and heaven.

He is remembered for saying: "People who place themselves before the sun get a tan; people who place themselves before the Eucharist become saints."

Carlo died at the age of 15 in 2006 shortly after being diagnosed with leukemia. Before he died, Carlo told his mother: "I offer all of my suffering to the Lord for the pope and for the Church in order not to go to purgatory but to go straight to heaven." — www.catholicnewsagency.com


