# Reflections From the Pastor

There are so many details to this story of the raising of Lazarus, but I will focus on a few. Lazarus represents each one of us. Martha tells Jesus, “Master, the one you love is ill.” We know that Jesus had a special bond with Lazarus, like he did with the apostle John. In the same way, the Lord loves you and has a special bond with you. God created you in His image and likeness. When we sin, someone can say to Jesus, “Master, the one you love is ill.” Lazarus’s death is representative of how we can be separated from God through mortal or deadly sin. Jesus still loves us, but He hates the sin and calls us to repentance and conversion. I am not saying the miracle of raising Lazarus from the dead did not happen. It did! In the Scriptures, especially in John’s writings, there is a physical meaning and a spiritual meaning.

It always strikes me that Jesus waited a couple of days to be with his friend who was ill. We sometimes wonder what God is doing when we are having problems and He doesn’t seem to answer. In this story, Jesus has a plan to show the glory of God through the resurrection of Lazarus. Although God’s ways may be difficult to understand in the moment, He invites us to trust in His will and His timing. Just like children don’t always understand their parents plan, we don’t understand God’s plan. We love our children and God loves us infinitely more.

The next thing that strikes me is Jesus’s reaction to the death of Lazarus. He is moved in the depth of His soul, to the point of crying. Remember, the death of Lazarus is symbolic of our spiritual death. Lazarus was in the tomb for four days and the stench was terrible. Our sin smells terribly and separates us from Jesus and the community. Jesus loves us and is pained by our sin, much like a parent is pained by a child’s sins. Sin binds us like Lazarus was wrapped in cloth. However, Jesus wants to work the same miracle in us that He did with Lazarus. He wants to raise us from our sins through His forgiveness. When we ask for forgiveness of our sins with a contrite heart, the Lord runs to us with mercy and compassion. He calls us out of the tomb by name, “\_\_\_\_\_, come out!”

Finally, nothing is impossible with God. Sometimes we think that we have sinned so terribly that God cannot forgive us. However, we see in this story that Jesus hates anything that separates us from Him and He is willing to go the depths and stench of our sin to rescue us.

Think about this the next time you are tempted to sin. Think about how it is going to lead you to the tomb with a big stone rolled in front of it. Think about being separated from Jesus, and He is crying outside the tomb. He tells us that we were not made for sin, we were made for greatness. We were made for holiness. We were made to live in His grace and to have an abundant life. We were made to stay out of the tomb. Don’t give in to sin. If you have fallen, know that the Lord seeks you with His infinite love and mercy. He loves you so much and wants to show His glory by calling you to rise from your sins through His forgiveness.

Have I experienced separating myself from God through my sin?

Have I ever felt my sins were unforgivable?

Have I experienced Jesus calling me out of the stench of my sin to live in His grace?

# Mass Minute #10

This is our weekly article that will include some catechesis and practical instructions on the Mass.

- 1) **Recite the Creed** – After the homily and a period of silence for reflection, the priest invites everyone to stand to recite the Creed together. There are two possible creeds. The Nicene Creed is longer and was established in 325 AD at the Council of Nicea. It walks us through what we believe regarding God the Father, Jesus, the Holy Spirit and the Church. The Apostles’ Creed is shorter and is also used during the praying of the rosary. It is important that we reconfirm our faith each week so that we do not forget our foundation. We bow during the Creed as we remember the incredible mystery of the Incarnation and God becoming a man to save us.
- 2) **Prayers of the Faithful / Universal Prayers** – After the Creed, we pray for the intentions of the Universal Church around the world. We usually pray for the Pope and other Church leaders, for civil leaders, for the sick, and for the dead. Every Mass has a special intention that the priest is offering. This is a great time for each person to offer your own intentions in your heart as well. We believe in the power of intercessory prayer. Everyone is seated after the priest closes the intentions with prayer, surrendering all to the will of God. This ends the Liturgy of the Word.
- 3) **Preparation of the Altar** – The deacon (or priest) goes to the altar to prepare for the Liturgy of the Eucharist. The Roman Missal is the large book of prayers that is placed on the altar. The chalice and paten are placed on a corporal, which is a white cloth meant to capture any crumbs. We believe that every piece of consecrated host is precious because it is the Body of Christ. Usually someone from the congregation will process up the main aisle with the bread and wine that will be consecrated during the Mass.

Next week we will talk about tithing, the prayers said quietly over the gifts, and the washing of the hands.







Due to hospital admitting policies, it is necessary to inform the office when hospitalized parishioners would like a visit from a priest or deacon or if you would like a visit while convalescing at a facility or at home. Before being admitted to a hospital for surgery it is advisable to call the office and arrange a time to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Please contact the office regarding communion visits to the homebound.
