

Reflections From the Pastor



22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

This weekend we have readings that encourage us in the great virtue of humility, which means "of the earth". Humility means that we live in the truth, and we have our feet planted firmly on the ground. We know our own strengths and weaknesses. We recognize that every good gift comes from God, and we thank Him. We also ask Him to strengthen our weaknesses. Some saints say that humility is the greatest virtue. Humility is the virtue that allows us to love because we are thinking less of ourselves and more of others.

In the first reading from Sirach, we read, "My child, conduct your affairs with humility, and you will be loved more than a giver of gifts. Humble yourself the more, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God." The devil tempted Jesus with honor and glory. The devil also tries to tempt us away from humility by the lure of honor and glory. I love to see athletes, musicians and entertainers give all the glory to God for their accomplishments.

In the Gospel of Luke today, we read a wonderful parable from Jesus. He had been trying to teach His disciples about humility and service. They were expecting a Messiah who would come with great power to establish his reign and yet Jesus's Kingdom would not be what everyone expected. Jesus came to serve, not to be served. He came as the suffering servant. He was born in a humble manger where animals fed. He washed the feet of His disciples. He would later die on a cross. In this parable, Jesus taught His disciples to seek the lowest place.

In our fallen human nature, we often seek the highest place. We like attention. We love to get accolades. We want to be better than everyone else and get recognized for our achievements. Our ego cries out for attention. This is especially true if we are not grounded in our identity as beloved children of God. We look to get our identity and worth from the honor other people give us.


To enter the Kingdom of God, it does not matter what our IQ is. It does not matter how much money we have. It does not matter what our job title is. The kingdom of heaven is about our willingness to love, to serve, to carry our cross, to seek the best for others. The world teaches us that this life is about us. Jesus teaches us that this life is about God and others. When we humble ourselves and love like Jesus, we find true joy. Humility is the key virtue as we grow as disciples of Jesus.


