At the heart of the night was the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, as attendees knelt in reverence and worship before the Eucharist. Surrounded by candlelight and live worship music, the atmosphere was one of deep prayer, reflection, and awe in the presence of Jesus.

Reflections From the Pastor



Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross

Today the Church celebrates the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. Christians today are accustomed to wearing crosses around our necks as a sign of our Christianity. It is a part of our culture. However, at the time of Jesus, the cross was the worst form of capital punishment that existed. It was a slow, humiliating, and torturous way to execute someone publicly. It is difficult to watch portions of "The Passion of the Christ" because of the horror Jesus experienced that day.

Why do we celebrate the cross? Jesus took the weight of the sins of the world upon His back, died on the cross, and three days later rose from the dead. God transformed the cross from representing a torturous means of execution into the glorious means of salvation.

The connection between this Gospel reading and the Old Testament first reading (Numbers 21:4 -9) is striking. Moses had led the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt into the desert. Even though God had just delivered them from slavery, the people began to complain because they had no food or drink. They did not trust God, who would give them manna from heaven and water from a rock. As they complained, serpents bit the Israelites and many of them died. Moses begged God for mercy, so God told Moses to make a serpent and mount it on a pole. Whoever looked upon this serpent on a pole would not die.

Like the Israelites enslaved in Egypt, we are slaves to sin. Even though we complain to God and are ungrateful at times, Jesus went to the cross to save us. The Son of Man was lifted high on the cross, "so everyone who believes in Him may have eternal life." (see John 3:16)

We have a God who loves us enough to endure the cross. His self-emptying love (kenosis) on the cross should stir something within our hearts. This was not a simple, peaceful death. This was an agonizing and brutal way to die. He did it for you and me. Take time today to meditate on the depth of God's love for you especially displayed by Jesus's willingness to die on the cross to save us.

One of the ways we can exult the cross is to accept with faith the cross that Jesus gives us to carry. Life is hard, and we are not in control. Sometimes we don't understand the crosses we are asked to bear, but we trust that Jesus is helping us carry the cross. Jesus kept His eyes on the Father while He walked the via dolorosa (the painful way). He invites us to do the same because the Father will see us through anything.
