# Reflections From the Pastor



## Palm Sunday – Spiritual Spring Training

I invite you and your families to walk this journey with our Lord this Holy Week. The Easter Triduum (this Thursday, Friday, Saturday) is a treasure and highlight of the Church calendar, culminating with the resurrection of Jesus.

**Monday** – 7:00am and 5:00pm daily Mass as normal. We will have several priests for confessions at 5:30pm.

**Tuesday** – 7:00am and 5:00pm daily Mass as normal.

**Wednesday** - 7:00am and 5:00pm daily Mass as normal.

- 9:50pm – Night Prayer from the Liturgy of the Hours will be offered in the Adoration Chapel. The chapel will be closed from 10:00pm Wednesday until after the Easter Vigil on Saturday (about 10:00pm).

**Holy Thursday** – 8:00am Morning Prayer.

- 7:00pm Mass of the Lord's Supper – This celebrates the institution of the Eucharist, institution of the Priesthood, and the Washing of the Feet.
- After Mass - Adoration until midnight. All are invited to visit seven local churches and pray with other parishioners on a local pilgrimage. This is an old tradition of the Church. We will supply the prayers. Each person/family is responsible for driving to each local parish.

**Good Friday** – 8:00am Morning Prayer. Today is a day of fasting and abstinence. To remember what Jesus did for us on that first Good Friday, Catholics should eat only one full meal and two smaller meals which, combined, would not equal a single normal meal. Additionally, Catholics may not eat meat today.

- 3:00pm - Celebration of the Lord's Passion and Veneration of the Cross
- 7:00pm – Stations of the Cross in the church.

**Holy Saturday** – 8:00am Morning Prayer. Our fast should continue through the day on Saturday. It is a time to recall that Jesus was placed in the tomb and there is silence on the earth.

- 8:30am – There will be several priests for confessions following Morning Prayer.
- 12:00pm – Bring your Easter food baskets for a special blessing.
- 8:00pm Easter Vigil Mass – celebrate with fellow parishioners who will be baptized, receive First Holy Communion, and Confirmation.

**Easter Sunday** – **NOTE THE MASS TIMES** - 6:30am, 8:00am, 10:00am and 12:00pm Masses, with extra Masses at 8:00am, 10:00am and 12:00pm in the Parish Center. Celebrate with us the joy of the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ! We will be giving each family a copy of the book "The Forgotten Way" by Matthew Kelly.

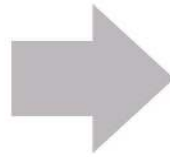

# MASS MINUTES FROM FATHER BURKE

*This is our weekly article that will include some catechesis and practical instructions on the Mass.*

Before receiving Holy Communion, we echo the humility of the centurion: “Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed” (Matthew 8:8). While he asked for his servant’s healing, we ask for the healing of our souls through Jesus in the Eucharist.

The Eucharist is the source and summit of our Catholic faith—truly the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ. Because of this, we must approach Holy Communion with reverence and in a state of grace. The Catechism reminds us: “Anyone conscious of a grave sin must receive the sacrament of Reconciliation before coming to Communion” (CCC 1385).

St. Paul gives a serious warning: receiving unworthily brings judgment upon ourselves (cf. 1 Corinthians 11:27-30). This is not meant to scare us, but to call us to deeper faith, repentance, and love.

So how can we prepare well?

- 1) Ask God for a deeper faith in the Real Presence. Like any relationship, love grows when we intentionally invest in it.
- 2) Examine your conscience. If you are aware of mortal sin, go to Confession before receiving Communion. For venial sins, participate attentively in the Penitential Rite at the beginning of Mass.
- 3) Receive Jesus with reverence. Whether in the hand or on the tongue, approach with focus and devotion, recognizing that you are encountering the Risen Lord.
- 4) After receiving, return to your pew and spend time in thanksgiving. This is a sacred moment of intimacy with Christ. We should stay at Mass until after the final blessing.
- 5) Live what you receive. As St. Augustine said, “Behold what you are; become what you receive.” The Eucharist strengthens us to go forth and live lives of sacrificial love.

The more intentionally we receive Holy Communion, the more it transforms our hearts—and our lives.
