Reflections From the Pastor



4th Sunday of Easter

Do you remember the old game show “*Name That Tune?*” Contestants would compete to identify a song in as few notes as possible: “I can name that tune in five notes!”... “I can do it in four!” I used to be pretty good at that game. My ears were trained by hours of listening to music, and I could recognize many songs almost instantly.

In today’s Gospel (John 10:1–10), Jesus calls Himself the Good Shepherd and says that His sheep recognize His voice. They follow Him because they know Him, and they will not follow a stranger. That image raises an important question: how well do I know the voice of Jesus?

We live in a world filled with competing voices. God is always speaking to us—but so are what spiritual tradition calls the three enemies of the soul: the devil, the world, and the flesh. The devil tempts and deceives, trying to pull us away from God. The world promises happiness through wealth, power, and honor. The flesh seeks comfort and pleasure above all else. These voices can be loud, alluring, and constant.

In Acts (2:14a, 36–41), we see the power of recognizing and responding to God’s voice. After Peter’s preaching, the people are “cut to the heart” and ask what they should do. Peter’s answer is simple: repent and be baptized. They listened, they responded, and their lives were transformed.

Learning to hear God’s voice takes practice. Just like learning to recognize music, it requires time and attention. Through prayer, Scripture, and the Sacraments, our spiritual ears become more attuned. Over time, we begin to notice the difference: God’s voice brings clarity, peace, and hope—even in challenge. The voice of the enemy brings confusion, anxiety, and discouragement.

I recently experienced a moment of temptation after a period of great joy in the Lord. In that moment, I recognized the voice of the enemy. I had a choice: follow that voice into sin and lose my peace, or follow the Good Shepherd and remain in His grace. By God’s grace, I chose to stay with Him—and the joy remained.

This week, consider: How am I training my ears to hear God’s voice? Am I spending time with the Good Shepherd each day – at Mass, in adoration, in reading the Scriptures.

If we stay close to Him, we won’t just recognize His voice—we’ll follow it. And that leads to the abundant life He promises.

JOURNEY TO 100 CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

Dear Parish Family,

I just finished walking through the school cafeteria which is currently under renovation. A true transformation is taking place and will be ready for students in the fall thanks to the hard work of our building committee and the generosity of our donors to the Journey to 100 capital campaign. You can get a sneak peak at the work during our Dusty Shoes tours following weekend masses June 20-21.

A second piece of the campaign was announced in my Easter communication: the purchase of a new priest residence. A key part of our parish growth is investing in our future leadership. We are thrilled to be moving forward with the purchase of a house at 128 S. Clay, just steps away from our church. This new home will double our current capacity, providing space for our pastor, parochial vicar, a retired priest, and seminarians. It is not only a practical solution but also a remarkably cost-effective one—offering more than twice the space at a significantly lower cost per square foot than renovation of our current home.

I am happy to share with you that we will close on the new priest residence on May 28, 2026. Funds for this residence are fully restricted and will not impact school or playground projects. With \$750,000 already raised, we are now inviting people to help us raise another \$925,000 so that we do not need to make interest payments on the house.

We will make good use of the current priest residence for the advancement of our parish goals to evangelize and make disciples. It will not be torn down. Conversations are currently underway to finalize the scope of use for the house and will be communicated soon.

Throughout this journey, we have remained committed to transparency, stewardship, and faith. And today, we can confidently say: this campaign is succeeding because of you. Now, we invite you to take the final step with us. As of the writing of this letter, we have \$19.8M pledged and \$15.6M collected on pledges from 876 households. We are in the home stretch of reaching our campaign goal of \$22.4M. Gifts at all levels are needed and appreciated. Please consider helping today.

St. Isaac Jogues Parish, united in faith and purpose, will bring these transformational projects fully to life, while we continue the mission of Jesus here on earth.

MASS MINUTES FROM FATHER BURKE

WHY EVERYONE SHOULD SING



Here's a simple truth: Mass is not a performance—it's participation. And one of the most powerful ways we participate is by singing.

I remember being in seminary, standing in a chapel with 200 men. When everyone sang together, it sent chills through your body. It wasn't about perfect pitch or polished voices—it was about unity. One voice, one prayer, rising to God. That's what the Church invites us into at every Mass.

The Scriptures remind us, "Sing joyfully to the Lord." Singing is not optional background noise; it is prayer. In fact, St. Augustine is often quoted as saying, "He who sings prays twice." When we sing, we engage not just our minds, but our hearts and our bodies. The music carries the words deeper into us.

Sometimes we hold back because we don't like our voice or we feel self-conscious. But here's the reality: if everyone sings, individual voices blend into something beautiful. No one stands out—and that's the point. It's not about sounding good; it's about giving glory to God.

So at the next Mass, don't sit on the sidelines. Open the hymnal. Lift your voice. Join the choir of the faithful. You might be surprised—your voice, united with others, can help lift hearts to heaven.
