





## **SACRAMENTAL PREP**



### **The First Communion Program**

Is a two-year program, candidates can join the program as long as they have started the First grade and up. Currently, our class schedule takes place on the First and third Sunday of each month, candidates are only allowed to have 3 absences. The class is from 9:15 am to 10:45 am. We need a copy of the baptism certificate. The class has a cost of \$100 per year, a total of \$200 for both years, and families are welcome to make monthly payments if needed. We ask you to register for each year. If you are continuing from Year 1 please register again for Year 2.

### **The Confirmation Program**

Is a 2-year program, candidates must be starting 9th grade of High School through 11th grade in order to join our program. Currently, our class schedule takes place on the First and third Sunday of each month, candidates are only allowed to have 3 absences. Class is from 2:30 to 6:00 pm, as candidates join the 5 pm Youth Mass. In addition to class time candidates are required to attend a 3 day away retreat, work volunteer hours, and attend 4 "Glorify" nights each semester (8 per year). These take place generally on the first 3 Sunday evenings of the month. The cost for the First Year is \$300 and the second year \$335 both include a 3 day away Retreat, families are welcome to make monthly payments if needed. We need a copy of the Baptism certificate and First Communion certificate of the candidate. We ask you to register for each year. If you are continuing from Year 1 please register again for Year 2.


