R.C.I.A. Penitential Rite

On the Second Sunday of Lent, the Church celebrates the Penitential Rite for the R.C.I.A. Candidates (those already baptized) who are preparing to receive both the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist and make a Profession of Faith into the Catholic Church. This ritual serves as a Lenten Purification for the Candidates through the Church's prayer for strengthening in grace, virtue and purification from all past evil and from any bonds which hinder them from experiencing the love of God. This Rite is part of their preparation for receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation and full sacramental reception into the Church at the Easter Vigil celebration. Let us all reflect on our own faith journey and during this Lenten Season bring ourselves to the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

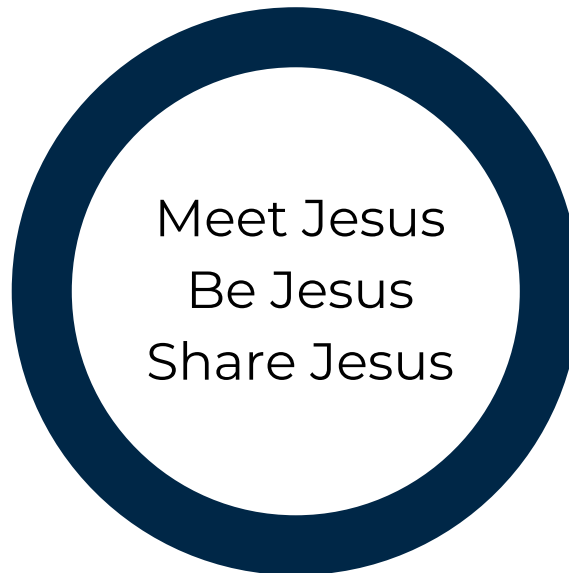

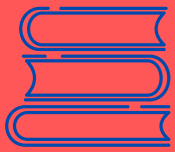
SAFETY TIP

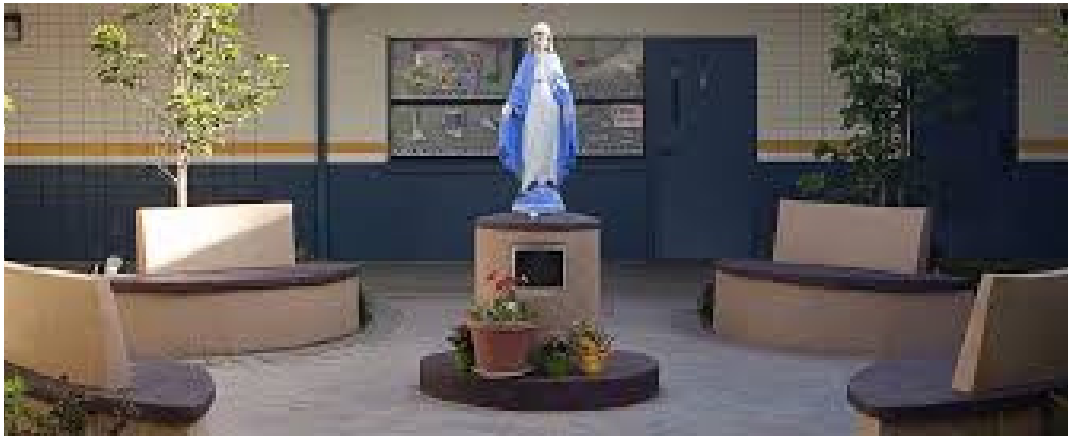
