

- Having mail accumulate can be a red flag and invite intruders. Kindly request that your neighbor collects the mail and hold it somewhere safe until you return.
- If you have a car, you may also want to ask your car neighbor to move your car around to make it appear as if you are home.
- Consider a program such as the app, Neighbors By Ring. You don't need a Ring device, and neighbors can easily share updates (crime, suspicious people, lost pets, etc).
- Create a neighborhood calling tree with a few trusted neighbors. Place it somewhere readily accessible so that in case of an emergency, you can quickly contact them.


