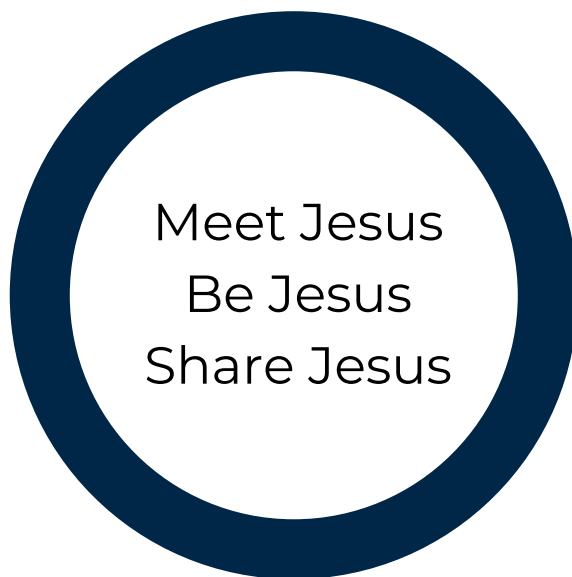

Throughout Easter Time, [the Church rejoices with Jesus, risen from the dead](#). Our readings on this Fourth Sunday of Easter celebrate our instinct to come together in joy, worshipping in church. The book of Revelation depicts a “great multitude” worshipping God “day and night in his temple.”

SAFETY TIP:

KEEP YOUR NEIGHBORS INFORMED

It's always smart to get to know your neighbors and reach a level where you can trust at least one. Inform a trusted neighbor that you will be away for a few days if there's a vacation coming up. Here's some tips on doing just that:

- If you plan to be away for a few days, give a copy of your keys to trusted neighbors so they can make sure everything is ok at home while you're away.
- **Having mail accumulate can be a red flag and invite intruders.** Kindly request that your neighbor collects the mail and hold it somewhere safe until you return.
- If you have a car, you may also want to ask your car neighbor to move your car around to make it appear as if you are home.
- Consider a program such as the app, Neighbors By Ring. You don't need a Ring device, and neighbors can easily share updates (crime, suspicious people, lost pets, etc).
- **Create a neighborhood calling tree with a few trusted neighbors.** Place it somewhere readily accessible so that in case of an emergency, you can quickly contact them.

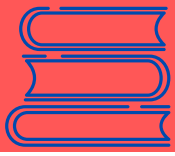

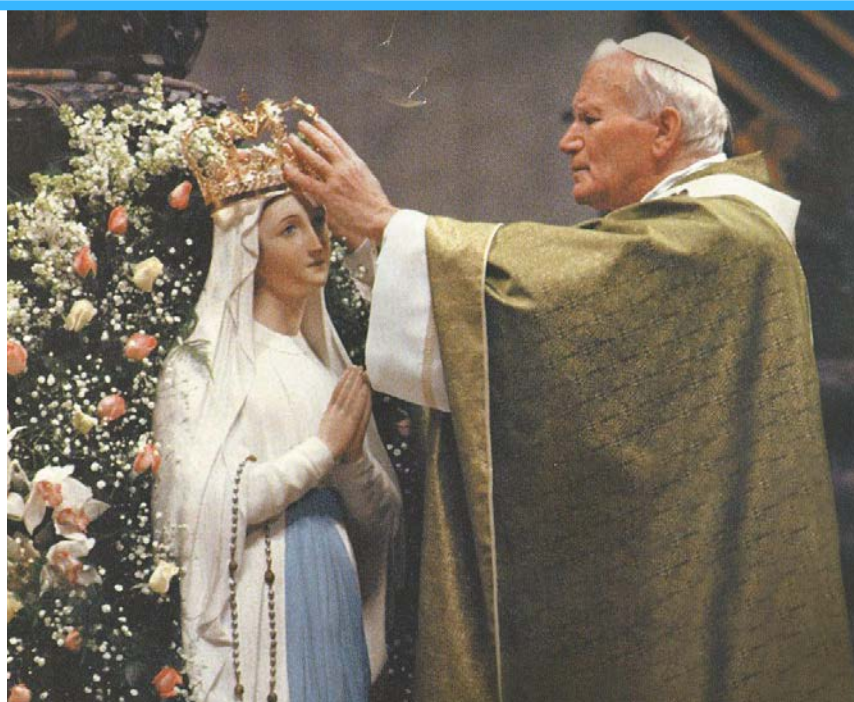

AMOR DE MADRE
Hay una sola criatura hermosa en el mundo, y es la de cada madre.

UN ANTICIPO DEL PARAÍSO

Durante todo el tiempo de Pascua, la Iglesia se alegra con Jesús, quien resucitó de la muerte. Nuestras lecturas para este Cuarto Domingo de Pascua celebran nuestra intuición de reunirnos alegremente, celebrando el culto en la Iglesia. Mientras que la oración privada alimenta nuestra relación con el Señor, la oración comunitaria es un anticipo del paraíso. El libro del Apocalipsis describe "una gran multitud" adorando a Dios "día y noche en su templo". Nuestras parroquias, el domingo de Pascua frecuentemente muestran a esta multitud alegre, llenando las bancas a reborar. Cuatro domingos después del inicio del tiempo festivo, se nos anima a seguir juntos alabando a Dios. En el libro de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, Pablo y Bernabé demuestran su intuición de adorar con su comunidad de fe cada sábado, ocupando obedientemente sus lugares en la sinagoga.
