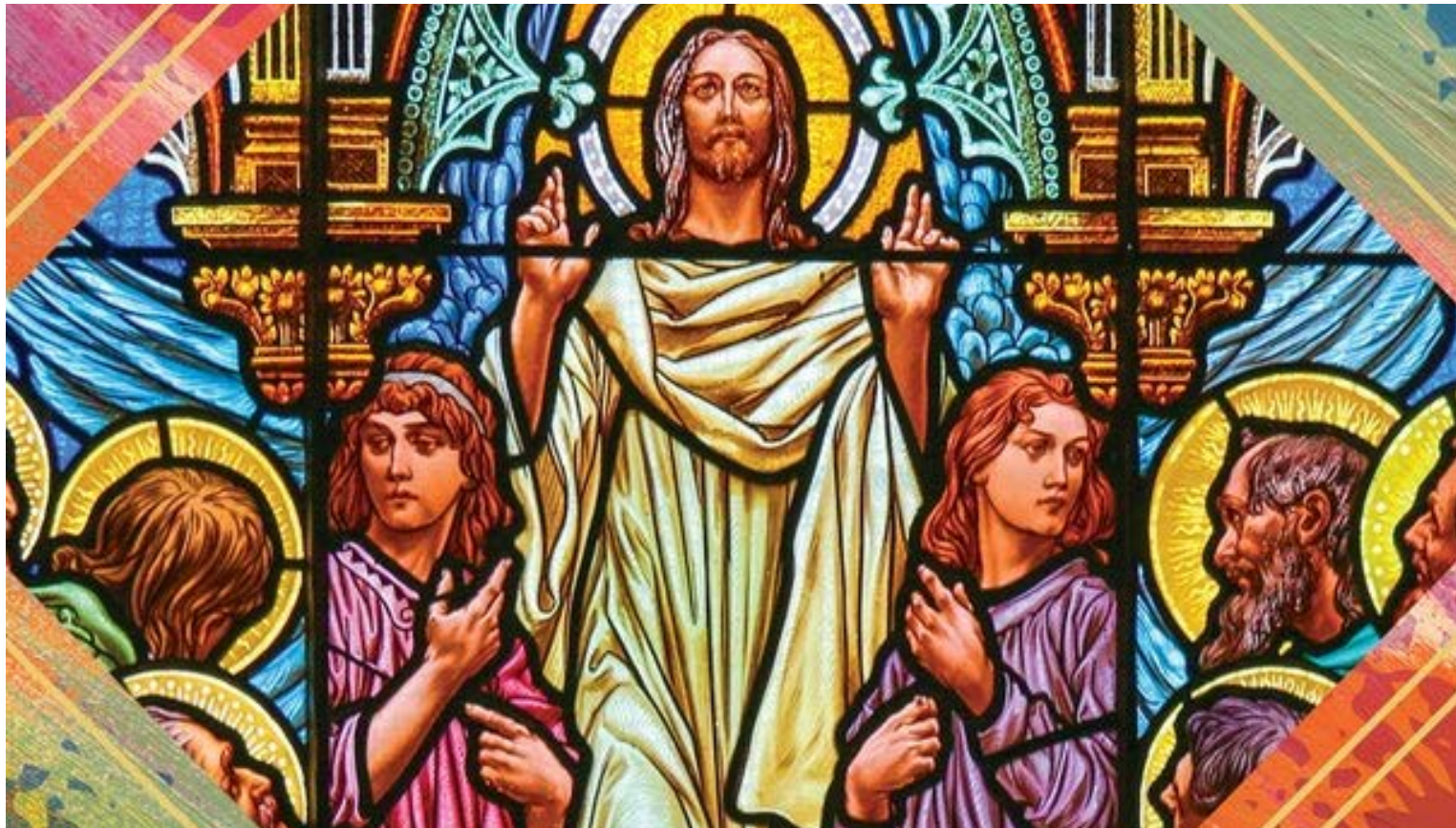

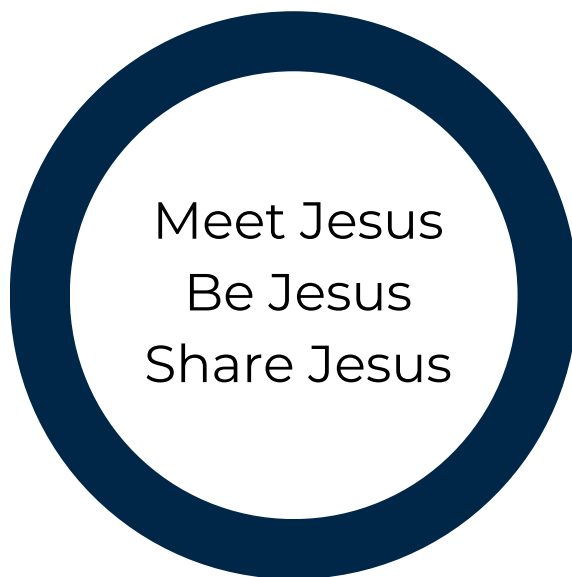

## Q AND A

Question:

What do the colors of the priest's and  
deacon's vestments mean?

Answer:

In the Roman Rite of the Catholic Church,  
the colors of the vestments evolved over  
the course of several centuries and there  
was wide variation both in the colors  
used, and in the feasts and seasons  
associated with particular colors. It was  
Pope Innocent III (d. 1216) who gave us  
the basic outline that was later prescribed  
by Pope Saint Pius V in 1570. The various  
colors remind us of the dominant themes  
of a particular season or celebration.

• **White:** Used for the seasons of  
Christmas and Easter and in celebrations  
of the Lord, of Mary, the angels, and  
saints who were not martyrs. This color is  
also used in Masses for the dead, at  
baptisms, weddings and other festive  
celebrations.

• **Red:** As the color of both blood and fire,  
red is used on Palm Sunday and Good  
Friday, as well as Pentecost and special  
celebrations of the Holy Spirit. Moreover,  
red is used on the feasts and memorials  
of the Apostles and those saints who died  
as martyrs.

• **Violet:** The color for Advent and Lent.  
Violet may also be used in Masses for the  
dead and on All Souls Day (November 2).

• **Green:** A color of life and hope, green is  
used throughout Ordinary Time.

• **Other colors:** Rose may be used on the  
Third Sunday of Advent and the Fourth  
Sunday of Lent, black may be used in  
Masses of the dead and on All Souls Day,  
gold or silver may be used on solemn  
occasions in place of white, red, or green.

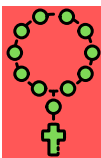

## FINGERPRINTING

St. Rose of Lima will be hosting multiple fingerprinting sessions this summer. If you are a parent or family member of children in our school, you must be fingerprinted in order to be on school campus, volunteer at the school or school events, or help out on field trips. [If you are a St. Rose parishioner who is involved in ministries or activities at the parish you must also be fingerprinted.](#) In keeping with the requirements of the Los Angeles Archdiocese, we want to make sure that ALL staff, volunteers and ministry members are duly fingerprinted and Virtus trained.

Here are some frequently asked questions!

**FAQ #1:** I was fingerprinted for my job with the school district, hospital, police department, etc.

Do I need to be fingerprinted again?

ANSWER: YES! Fingerprints from other organizations cannot be viewed by the Archdiocese, which is why we have our own fingerprinting capabilities.

**FAQ #2:** I think I was fingerprinted a long time ago, but can't remember. Do I need to be fingerprinted again?

ANSWER: Contact Nicole Pizano at [safeguard@strosesv.com](mailto:safeguard@strosesv.com) or by text at 818-935-7979 and she can check the system to see if you have been fingerprinted by the Archdiocese.

**FAQ #3:** I am a lector, usher, or member of a ministry that does not work with kids. Do I need to be fingerprinted?

ANSWER: YES! No matter what ministry you are in, there will always be a time when children are around. For their safety, that we ask that ALL school and parish ministry members and volunteers be fingerprinted.

### NUESTRA FASCINANTE FE

Los siete santos fundadores de la Orden de los Siervos El 17 de febrero honramos a los siete santos fundadores de la Orden de los Siervos de la Virgen María. Bonfilius, Alexis, Manettus, Amideus, Hugh, Sostene y Buonagiunta eran un grupo de comerciantes de Florencia que, al experimentar una aparición de la Santísima Virgen en 1233, renunciaron a sus negocios, dejaron lo necesario para sus familias y distribuyeron el resto entre los pobres. Luego se dedicaron por completo a la veneración de la Virgen María, yendo a vivir a una montaña italiana, asumiendo cada uno la vida de un ermitaño: oración, ayuno extremo y penitencia. Tiempo después, a petición del delegado del Papa, todos menos uno fueron ordenados sacerdotes. El hermano Alexis, considerándose indigno del sacerdocio, decidió permanecer como hermano. Todos fueron canonizados en 1888. Su fiesta, originalmente el 11 de febrero, cae ahora el 17, fecha de la muerte del último de los siete fundadores. El Hermano Alexis murió a la edad de 110 años.
