

THE HARDNESS OF HOLINESS

Want to know the words I find hardest to say? "Lord, give me the strength."

The world tells us to push ourselves outside of our comfort zone if we're training for a marathon or applying for a job — but if we're talking about God, everything is supposed to be easy. If it comes "naturally" or without struggle it's supposed to be right.

Only God is perfect, the world tells us. What's the use of trying so hard? I'm really good at finding excuses for myself, especially when it comes to holiness. Holiness, often (not always, but often), is about choosing the hard, but right, thing. The invitation to holiness is whispered in the hardest moments of my day when I am the most hopelessly human. After the kids' bedtime, when I really just want to watch Dateline and eat too much ice cream instead of saying the Rosary. When I've committed to helping someone, but it suddenly becomes incredibly inconvenient. When I see a social media post that's just begging for a snarky reply. When the conversation becomes gossip and I'm dying to make myself feel superior to someone.

The reason it's so difficult for me to mutter these five simple words is because I know that if I say them and I mean them, they form a prayer that God will always answer in the affirmative. He will give me the strength I ask for, and then I will have no excuse.

It's not unlike my kids claiming they're too tired to clean up the playroom. If they would just ask me for help, it would all be so doable. But where would that leave them? With a job to do, that's where.

FINGERPRINTING

St. Rose of Lima will be hosting multiple fingerprinting sessions this summer. If you are a parent or family member of children in our school, you must be fingerprinted in order to be on school campus, volunteer at the school or school events, or help out on field trips. If you are a St. Rose parishioner who is involved in ministries or activities at the parish you must also be fingerprinted. In keeping with the requirements of the Los Angeles Archdiocese, we want to make sure that ALL staff, volunteers and ministry members are duly fingerprinted and Virtus trained.

Here are some frequently asked questions!

FAQ #1: I was fingerprinted for my job with the school district, hospital, police department, etc.

Do I need to be fingerprinted again?

ANSWER: YES! Fingerprints from other organizations cannot be viewed by the Archdiocese, which is why we have our own fingerprinting capabilities.

FAQ #2: I think I was fingerprinted a long time ago, but can't remember. Do I need to be fingerprinted again?

ANSWER: Contact Nicole Pizano at safeguard@strosesv.com or by text at 818-935-7979 and she can check the system to see if you have been fingerprinted by the Archdiocese.

FAQ #3: I am a lector, usher, or member of a ministry that does not work with kids. Do I need to be fingerprinted?

ANSWER: YES! No matter what ministry you are in, there will always be a time when children are around. For their safety, that we ask that ALL school and parish ministry members and volunteers be fingerprinted.

la fugacidad de la vida humana o la humildad del arrepentimiento.

Las cenizas también pueden representar otras cosas.

Por ejemplo, las cenizas se utilizan a menudo para

fertilizar nuestros jardines y campos. Por lo tanto, la

ceniza es necesaria para dar vida y nutrirla. Ahora podemos empezar a ver cuán apropiado es el

símbolo de la ceniza para el tiempo de Cuaresma.


