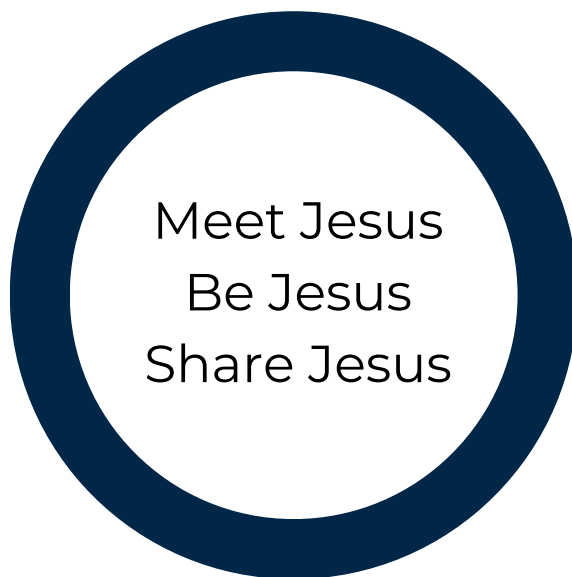

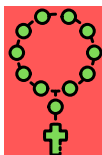

NEW BIBLE STUDY - THE BOOK OF MATTHEW

The new Bible study on the Book of Matthew **starts on Thursday, April 13, 2023, in room 8 at SROL School at 7pm.**

We start with an introductory lecture followed by five sessions. We watch a video together and have a discussion on the questions that are provided. There is a reading assignment between each session. Standing at the start of the New Testament, the Gospel of Matthew provides a bridge from the Jewish world awaiting a Messiah to the emerging Christian world of Jesus and his followers.

This Gospel introduces us to Jesus as the Master Teacher whose words of instruction are captured in large teaching sections. **Part One covers Matthew 1:1-16:28**, from the birth of Jesus through much of his public teaching life, to the first prediction of his passion. Commentary, study and reflection questions, prayer, and access to online lectures are included.

Book Author information: Barbara E. Reid, OP, PhD, is a Dominican Sister of Grand Rapids, Michigan. She is professor of New Testament studies at Catholic Theological Union, Chicago, and she served as vice president and academic dean at CTU from 2009 to 2018.
