EMAIL SCAM

There have been several Bogus emails sent supposedly from Fr Shea or the parish asking for money or gift cards.

Forward any suspicious email to webmaster@strosesv.com. If the parish was collecting money for a charity or cause we do it by directing you to our website at www.strosesv.com and collect the money from there. To clarify, all valid emails from St. Rose of Lima end in @strosesv.com or @srls.org, not @gmail.com or @yahoo.com. There is a scam in progress.

Any questions please call the rectory at 805-526-1732. In general, never click on a link in an email that you were not expecting. To summarize, never send money or gift cards to ANYONE based solely on an email or text message - **always verify via phone or website.**

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

In Eucharistic Adoration, we honor the Eucharistic Presence of Christ and contemplate the Mystery of Christ truly present before us. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament flows from the sacrifice of the Mass and serves to deepen our hunger for communion with Christ and the rest of the Church. During Eucharistic Adoration, we remain silent in Christ's Presence and open ourselves to His graces which flow from the Eucharist.

St. Rose of Lima has Eucharistic Adoration six days a week, beginning every Monday after the 8:30am mass and continuing 24 hours/day until the 5:00pm mass on Saturday.

Flight from LAX to Guanajuato City and transfer to hotel.

Overnight stay at a 4 Star hotel.

DAY 2, JUNE 10, Saturday - GUANAJUATO / CHRISTO RAY :

City tour - Explore the colorful alleyways, city history, incredible sites, colonial architecture, festivals, the Juarez Theater, a UNESCO World Heritage Site; Pipila Monument, the Alhondiga de Granaditas etc. We will also get to see basilica shaped like a globe and the World's Largest Bronze 'Christ the King' statue made by Mexican sculptor Fidias Elizondo - **measures 65 feet tall and weighs 160,000 lbs.** Christ the King and the Cathedral. Breakfast at hotel. **Tour San Miguel de Allende**, a colonial city known for its Spanish baroque architecture and culture. In the cobblestone historic center is the Neo-Gothic Parroquia de San Miguel Archangel and the main square, El Jardin. Visit the 18th century **Templo de San Francisco** with its Churrigueresque facade, the beautiful Nuestra Senora de la Salud, Benito Juarez Park and El Chorro promenade. Shop at the Mercado de Artesanias. Dinner and overnight stay at a 4-Star hotel at Queretaro.
