form of residence restriction to

committing repeat crimes.

These laws exist and have an impact, but they are only one layer of protection and are not a guarantee that a park, bus stop or other space is safe.



EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

In Eucharistic Adoration, we honor the Eucharistic Presence of Christ and contemplate the Mystery of Christ truly present before us. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament flows from the sacrifice of the Mass and serves to deepen our hunger for communion with Christ and the rest of the Church. During Eucharistic Adoration, we remain silent in Christ's Presence and open ourselves to His graces which flow from the Eucharist.

St. Rose of Lima has Eucharistic Adoration six days a week, beginning every Monday after the 8:30am mass and continuing 24 hours/day until the 5:00pm mass on Saturday.

Eucharistic Adoration is held in the Adoration Chapel, located on the west side of the church, and all Catholics are invited to come and adore the Blessed Sacrament.

21 de Mayo de 2023 Septimo Domingo de Pascua En el mes de mayo, ¿qué puede hacer María por ti?

Nunca olvidaré una historia que un seminarista contó un día en clase durante la homilía de práctica que predicó.

Antes de entrar en el seminario, este joven había servido en la Marina. Mientras estaba desplegado en Irak, su madre le envió por correo un paquete que contenía, entre otras cosas, 120 escapularios de color café, el escapulario que honra a Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo.

El joven distribuyó los escapularios entre sus compañeros de la Marina. Pero en su unidad, había un enorme y distante compañero que le daba hasta miedo. Y el joven se preguntaba si debía darse la oportunidad de ofrecerle un escapulario. Pero entonces, pensándolo mejor, se armó de valor y le dio uno. El marino que le provocaba miedo, lo miró con una fuerte mirada... y luego se abrió su chaqueta antibalas con ímpetu.

El miembro de la Marina llevaba puestos siete escapularios de color café.

El joven hombre estaba estupefacto. "¿Qué?" Dijo el Marino de complexión fuerte. "Maria es mamá. Ella pensará que es lindo".



El papel que Dios en su plan de salvación confió a María ilumina la vocación de la mujer en la vida de la Iglesia y de la sociedad, definiendo su diferencia con respecto al hombre. En efecto, el modelo que representa María muestra claramente lo que es específico de la personalidad femenina.

María, realizando esa forma de cooperación tan sublime, indica también el estilo mediante el cual la mujer debe cumplir concretamente su misión.

Ante el anuncio del ángel, la Virgen no manifiesta una actitud de reivindicación orgullosa, ni busca satisfacer ambiciones personales. San Lucas nos la presenta como una persona que sólo deseaba brindar su humilde servicio con total y confiada disponibilidad al plan divino de salvación. Este es el sentido de la respuesta: «He aquí la esclava del Señor; hágase en mí según tu palabra» (Lc 1,38).

En efecto, no se trata de una acogida puramente pasiva, pues da su consentimiento sólo después de haber manifestado la dificultad que nace de su propósito de virginidad, inspirado por su voluntad de pertenecer más totalmente al Señor.

Después de haber recibido la respuesta del ángel, María expresa inmediatamente su disponibilidad, conservando una actitud de humilde servicio.

Se trata del humilde y valioso servicio que tantas mujeres, siguiendo el ejemplo de María, han prestado y siguen prestando en la Iglesia para el desarrollo del reino de Cristo.
