



During Eucharistic Adoration, we remain silent in Christ's Presence and open ourselves to His graces which flow from the Eucharist.

St. Rose of Lima has Eucharistic Adoration six days a week, beginning every Monday after the 8:30am mass and continuing 24 hours/day until the 5:00pm mass on Saturday.

Eucharistic Adoration is held in the Adoration Chapel, located on the west side of the church, and all Catholics are invited to come and adore the Blessed Sacrament.


