To all, charity.


And to God...your eternal gratitude for His Son our Savior and the saving grace He bought for us...and oh, yes, the gift of yourself to God.

DID YOU KNOW THAT?

What is a trial balloon?

One of the best ways safe adults can help children who are suffering from abuse is to recognize and listen to their disclosures — even if they are done in stages or in subtle ways. A child may float a "trial balloon" disclosure, meaning he may use a single sentence or phrase to see if a safe adult will respond appropriately.

Be on the lookout for sudden disclosures like, "I don't want to go to So-and-so's house anymore," and try responding in a way designed to let the child continue to open up: "Do you want to tell me why?" or "Let's talk about that," for example. The nearby pregnancy clinic told us during the campaign at least four moms chose life for their babies as a result of seeing or interacting with prayer warriors outside Planned Parenthood.

The battle for life is difficult, especially here in California but we will continue to bring awareness to the destruction and death that abortion brings to families.

We will continue to pray outside Planned Parenthood in Thousand Oaks year 'round. Please join us for an hour, the first week of each month, Monday (11, 12, 1, and 3 pm), Tuesday (12, 1, and 4 pm) or Wednesday (12 through 6) when the abortion clinic is open.

Or, weekly, or biweekly. No contact with staff or clients is necessary. You will not be alone – we will join you if you don't bring a friend or family member with you. If not you, then who? Please help us bring The Beginning of the End of Abortion to Thousand Oaks.
