

#### **FATHER DIEGO CABRERA ROJAS, SSC**

Father Diego Cabrera Rojas is a priest of the Missionary Society of St. Columban. Born in the district of Camporredondo, province of Luya, Amazonas region, Peru, he has developed an outstanding academic, pastoral, and missionary career across Latin America, Oceania, and the United States. He completed his secondary education at the Instituto Nacional Industrial INI 64 "Enrique Fracchia" in Lima. Later, he studied Psychology at the National University of San Marcos and Literature at the Enrique Guzmán y Valle University. He completed his philosophical and theological training at the Instituto Superior de Estudios Teológicos Juan XXIII.

As part of his pastoral formation, he was assigned to missions in Chile and Fiji, where he worked especially with the Indo-Fijian community, deepening his commitment to service and intercultural evangelization. He was ordained a priest in Lima in 1995. In 1996, he returned to Fiji, where he ministered for approximately six years. Upon returning to Peru, he served as Vocational Director for the Missionary Society of St. Columban. In 2007, he was elected Regional Superior for the Society in Peru, a role he fulfilled for four years.

In 2012, he was assigned to the United States, where he served as Associate Pastor at St. John of God Parish in Norwalk, Los Angeles, until 2015. That same year, he was appointed Pastor and Administrator of Saint Hilary of Perpetual Adoration Parish, a position he held until 2025. In July 2025, he was assigned as Associate Pastor at Saint Rose of Lima Parish, where he continues his pastoral ministry serving the community.





What makes a child feel safe enough to disclose abuse?

There are several factors that contribute to whether a child is comfortable disclosing abuse to an adult. Children are more likely to talk about problems when they: have access to an adult they can trust; are able to understand that what is happening to them is not normal or safe; and trust that they will be believed.

Another factor that may help a child disclose abuse is when a safe adult is intentional and asks direct questions about a child's life as it communicates caring and attention to the child's life circumstances. 




