STEWARDSHIP - A WAY OF LIVING

From this Sunday's Readings

"I am the Lord who brought you from Ur of the Chaldeans to give you this land as a possession." (GENESIS 15:7)

This line from the Old Testament offers two challenges. First, do you give to God from your "first fruits" - the first and best that you have to offer, or do you give from what you have leftover? Second, do you realize that everything you have and that everything you are has been given to you by God? Ask God for a grateful and generous heart, everyday, in all circumstances.

How much should I give?

Faithful Catholics are expected to give to the Lord with a grateful heart. The amount is meant to be a sacrifice - not what is convenient or easy. For example, for those who are working, a minimum amount is one hour's household pay per week.
