STEWARDSHIP - A WAY OF LIVING

FROM THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS

31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's reading from the book of Wisdom presents an image of a patient God who "rebuke[s] offenders little by little" (Wisdom 12:2), an image endorsed by the psalmist, singing of how the Lord is "slow to anger and of great kindness, and compassionate toward all his works" (Psalm 145:8, 9). The crowd with Jesus, however, grumbles when they see Jesus's kindness and compassion extended to Zacchaeus, who was not just a tax collector, but the "chief tax collector"—a title that surely emphasizes his standing as a sinner to be scorned. In the second reading, Saint Paul urges the Thessalonians to be "worthy" of God's calling, so that "the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you" (2 Thessalonians 1:12); such people, unlike the crowd in the Gospel, would rejoice at Zacchaeus's determination to change his life after encountering Jesus.

Be aware of airbag dangers for young children

An airbag can save your life, but for a young, small child, air bags pose a serious risk. All new cars have front seat airbags, so be aware of where your child should sit in the car to be safe for his or her age. All children in rearfacing car seats must ride in the back seat. Even in a low-speed crash, the airbag can inflate and hit a car seat in the front seat, causing serious injury. Know the laws in your state and check your car's owner's manual for more information on how best to ride safely with children in your car.

Updating our Parish Center to Benefit both our Parish Community and Our School

When Msgr. O'Leary arrived at SMT in 1979, he began at once to plan and build our parish center. He did so with an eye for aesthetics and beauty, creating a state-of-the-art facility to serve the needs of our parish and school for meetings and activities. The placement of his name on the building expresses our appreciation for his achievements and for his faithful service as Pastor for 34 years and as Pastor Emeritus for 9 years.

After 40 years, it is time for us to improve the functionality of the facility and to restore its beauty and luster with new flooring, lighting, painting, acoustic-absorptive finishes, improved storage and seating solutions. We will also redesign the two entrances to make them more welcoming and make extensive improvements to our much-beloved room 1, including a new double glass door entry to the patio (in place of a window) for better entertainment options. In addition, we will incorporate 21st Century technology in the building, make necessary enhancements to our utilities, and refresh the restrooms.
