

Second Sunday of Lent

First Reading: Genesis 22:1-2, 9a, 10-13, 15-18

Abraham was willing to sacrifice his own son - his own dream for the future, and to trust in God's will.

<u>Reflection Question</u>: Do I honestly place God's will first in my life or do I just seek God's blessings on my own plans? Who's counsel do I seek when I try to discern God's will?

Second Reading: Romans 8:31b-34

God is "for us" (in favor of) and sent his son not to condemn us, but to intercede for us and raise us up. God is for me. God loves me.

Reflection Question: Do I really believe that God is for me - that God is on my side - that God loves me? How do I know if I am on God's side?

Gospel: Mark 9:2-10

Jesus is transfigured. "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him."

<u>Discussion Question</u>: Share if you have ever had a moment of revelation about another person who you thought you knew but acted in a way much greater than you expected. Have I become the person that others wanted me to be or am I truly my own self?

Action

- I ask the Lord to help me discover the goodness of my own being. Just as the inner mystery of Jesus was revealed, may I discover the wonder of my own creation!
- Look into a mirror and express some positive affirmation about yourself.

 Reflect on the reality of children who are being sacrificed because of war, forced immigration, child trafficking, etc. And ask yourself; is there anything that you can do for them?
- Lent might be a good time for a spiritual retreat.
- As part of my Lenten Journey, I might want to read some of the spiritual materials regarding Lent. I might want to make a sacrifice during Lent to contribute to the parish.

<u>Prayer</u>

Oh God who did not spare your only Son but handed him over to us, help us see his presence in others and especially in children and to defend their dignity. Amen.


