Year of St. Joseph



The Vatican Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments on Saturday introduced 7 new invocations to the litany in honour of St. Joseph. The initiative comes during the Year of St. Joseph which Pope Francis declared from 8 December 2020, to 8 December 2021.

In a letter to the presidents of bishops' conferences around the world, the Secretary of the Congregation, Archbishop Arthur Roche and Undersecretary, Father Corrado Maggioni, SMM, explained the reason behind the move. "On the 150th anniversary of the proclamation of Saint Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church, the Holy Father, Pope Francis, published the Apostolic Letter *Patris corde*, with the aim 'to increase our love for this great saint, to encourage us to implore his intercession and to imitate his virtues and his zeal'," they wrote. "In this light, it appeared opportune to update the Litany in honour of Saint Joseph, approved by the Apostolic See in 1909, by integrating seven new invocations drawn from the interventions of the Popes who have reflected on aspects of the figure of the Patron of the Universal Church."

The new invocations are: *Guardian of the Redeemer, Servant of Christ, Minister of salvation, Support in difficulties, Patron of exiles, Patron of the afflicted and Patron of the poor.*

With these additions, the invocations in the Litany to St. Joseph now rise to 31.

La Congregación Vaticana para el Culto Divino y la Disciplina de los Sacramentos presentaron el sábado 7 nuevas invocaciones a la letanía en honor a San José. La iniciativa se produce durante el Año de San José que el Papa Francisco declaró del 8 de diciembre de 2020 al 8 de diciembre de 2021. En una carta a los presidentes de las conferencias episcopales de todo el mundo, el Secretario de la Congregación, monseñor Arthur Roche y el Subsecretario, padre Corrado Maggioni, SMM, explicaron la razón detrás de la medida. "En el 150 aniversario de la proclamación de San José como Patrono de la Iglesia Universal, el Santo Padre, el Papa Francisco, publicó la Carta Apostólica *Patris corde*, con el objetivo de 'aumentar nuestro amor por este gran santo, animarnos a implosionar su intercesión e imitar sus virtudes y su celo'", escribieron. "Desde este punto de vista, parecía oportuno actualizar la Letanía en honor a San José, aprobada por la Sede Apostólica en 1909, integrando siete nuevas invocaciones extraídas de las intervenciones de los Papas que han reflexionado sobre aspectos de la figura del Patrono de la Iglesia Universal."

Las nuevas invocaciones son: Guardián del Redentor, Siervo de Cristo, Ministro de Salvación, Apoyo en dificultades, Patrono de los exiliados, Patrono de los afligidos y Patrono de los pobres.

Con estas adiciones, las invocaciones en la Letanía a San José ascienden ahora a 31.

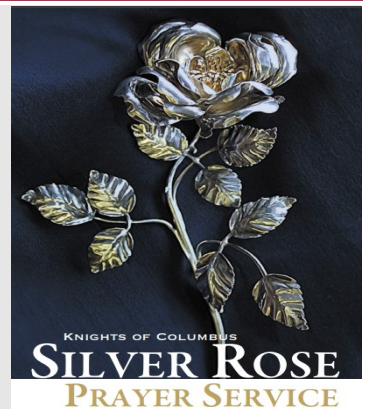

St. Mary and St. Joseph Pastorate Vision Plan Survey Thank You!

Thank you to all parishioners who filled out our survey. Our team is busy thoughtfully evaluating the results and will be working to develop a Pastorate Vision Plan. We will present this plan at all Masses in the near future. Once the Vision Plan is established, a copy will be mailed to all households and presented at Mass by a member of our Leadership Team. We are excited about the future of our pastorate!



Pastoral Vision Planning for each pastorate is an integral part of Uniting in Heart 2030. Currently, there are four pastorates going through a pilot phase of the vision planning process with Our Sunday Visitor, in which they have begun to develop their 3-Year Rolling Pastoral Plans. The process begins when a formal pastoral council has been formed, and a pastorate survey of all parishioners has been conducted. The survey inventories parishioner's experiences related to the following categories: Parish COVID-19 Response; Uniting in Heart; Spirituality and Pastoral Response; Communication; Ministries, Service, Hospitality, and Evangelization; Stewardship of Treasure; The Faith Life of You and Your Family; and the Future of our Pastorate. After the survey responses have been collated, the team spends time in prayer and reflection and through the power of the Holy Spirit, discerns what areas need the most focus in the pastorate. Using the guidance and resources provided in the Uniting in Heart Pastorate Guide, the pastorate leadership team, pastoral council, financial council(s) representative(s), and pastorate consultant hold meetings with a coach from OSV to develop the goals and benchmarks that they discern are appropriate for their pastorate over the next three years. When goals are well defined with measurable metrics that can be shared, the plan is put into a formal Pastorate Vision Plan brochure that is tailored to the specific pastorate and shared with parishioners. This allows the whole pastorate community to understand, acknowledge and ultimately participate in executing and meeting the goals set by the pastorate. There are three additional waves of Pastorate Vision Planning that each pastorate will take part in as they are ready. As of today, the current status of the pastorates are as follows: (see page 4)

La elaboración, en cada pastorado, de un plan y visión pastoral para los próximos tres años es una parte integral de *Uniting in Heart 2030*. Actualmente, hay 4 pastorados que atraviesan una fase piloto del proceso de planificación de la visión con *Our Sunday Visitor*, en la que han comenzado a desarrollar su Plan Pastoral Continuo de 3 años. El proceso comienza cuando se forma un consejo pastoral y se aplica una encuesta pastoral a todos los feligreses. La encuesta hace un inventario de las experiencias de los feligreses en las siguientes categorías: Respuesta de la parroquia ante el COVID-19; Unidos de Corazón; Espiritualidad y Respuesta Pastoral; Comunicación; Ministerios, Servicios, Hospitalidad y Evangelización; Promoción de Contribuciones y Donaciones; Su Vida de Fe, Usted y su familia; y el Futuro de Nuestro Pastorado. PASTORATE NEWS

Después de que se recopilen las respuestas de la encuesta, el equipo dedica tiempo a la oración y la reflexión y, a través del poder del Espíritu Santo, discierne qué áreas necesitan más atención en el pastorado. Utilizando la guía y los recursos proporcionados en la Guía Pastoral Unidos de Corazón, el equipo de liderazgo pastoral, el consejo pastoral, los representantes de los consejos financieros y el consultor pastoral se reúnen con un consultor de OSV para escoger las metas y los puntos de referencia que se consideren apropiados para su pastorado, durante los próximos tres años. Cuando las metas están bien definidas con métricas mensurables que se pueden compartir, el plan se coloca en un folleto formal del Plan de Visión Pastoral que se adapta al pastorado específico y se comparte con los feligreses. Esto permite que toda la comunidad pastoral comprenda, reconozca y, en última instancia, participe en la ejecución y el cumplimiento de las metas establecidas por el pastorado. Hay 3 olas adicionales de Planificación de la Visión Pastoral en las que cada pastorado participará cuando esté listo. Por ahora, el estado actual de los pastorados es el siguiente:
