

They have agreed to hear a case from Mississippi which could have an incredible effect on the question of abortion in our country. The case involves the question of "Whether all pre-viability prohibitions on elective abortions are unconstitutional?"

In the 1970's that question would have been answered one way. We pray that a different answer is given during this coming year. It is likely that a decision will not be rendered until next June. So, we need to be vigilant in our prayers.


