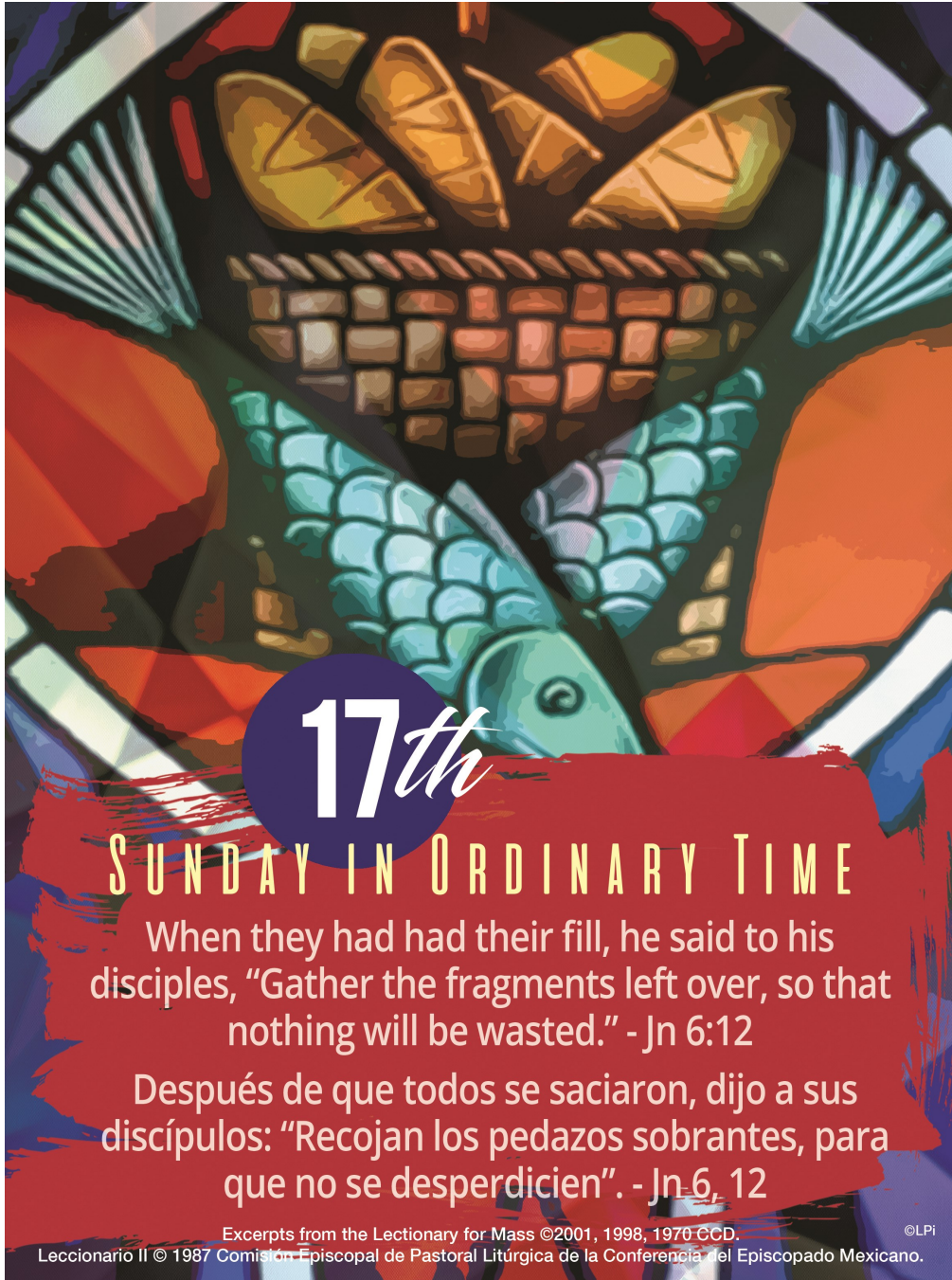

Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

I want to remind everyone of the proper etiquette in scheduling Funerals. Under normal circumstances after a death has occurred the family meets with the Funeral Director, at that time the Funeral Director makes contact with the church concerning scheduling the funeral. After a time is confirmed the Funeral Home then publicizes the arrangements.

Occasionally the scheduling takes place between the family and the church. This is often a mistake. When a family experiences a death they often are not thinking very clearly and can easily misunderstand things. This is through no fault of their own, it is just because they have experienced a profoundly sad experience.

The Funeral Home should never publish a date for a funeral at a church without talking with the church. This is because the church may have another funeral or something else scheduled at that time.

I am writing this note for clarity so that we can avoid any issues. Obviously, the parish will want to schedule a funeral at a time which is most convenient with the deceased's family.



Estimados feligreses,

Quiero recordarles a todos la etiqueta adecuada al programar funerales. En circunstancias normales, después de que ha ocurrido una muerte, la familia se reúne con el Director de la funeraria, en ese momento el Director de la funeraria se pone en contacto con la iglesia para programar el funeral. Después de un tiempo confirmado, la Funeraria da a conocer los arreglos.

Ocasionalmente, la programación se lleva a cabo entre la familia y la iglesia. Suele ser un error. Cuando una familia sufre una muerte, a menudo no piensa con mucha claridad y puede malinterpretar fácilmente las cosas. Esto no es por culpa de ellos, es solo porque han experimentado una experiencia profundamente triste.

La Funeraria nunca debería publicar la fecha de un funeral en una iglesia sin hablar con la iglesia. Esto se debe a que la iglesia puede tener otro funeral o algo más programado para ese momento.

Escribo esta nota para mayor claridad para que podamos evitar cualquier problema. Obviamente, la parroquia querrá programar un funeral en el momento que sea más conveniente para la familia del difunto.

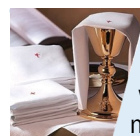

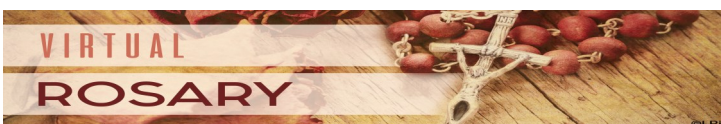
