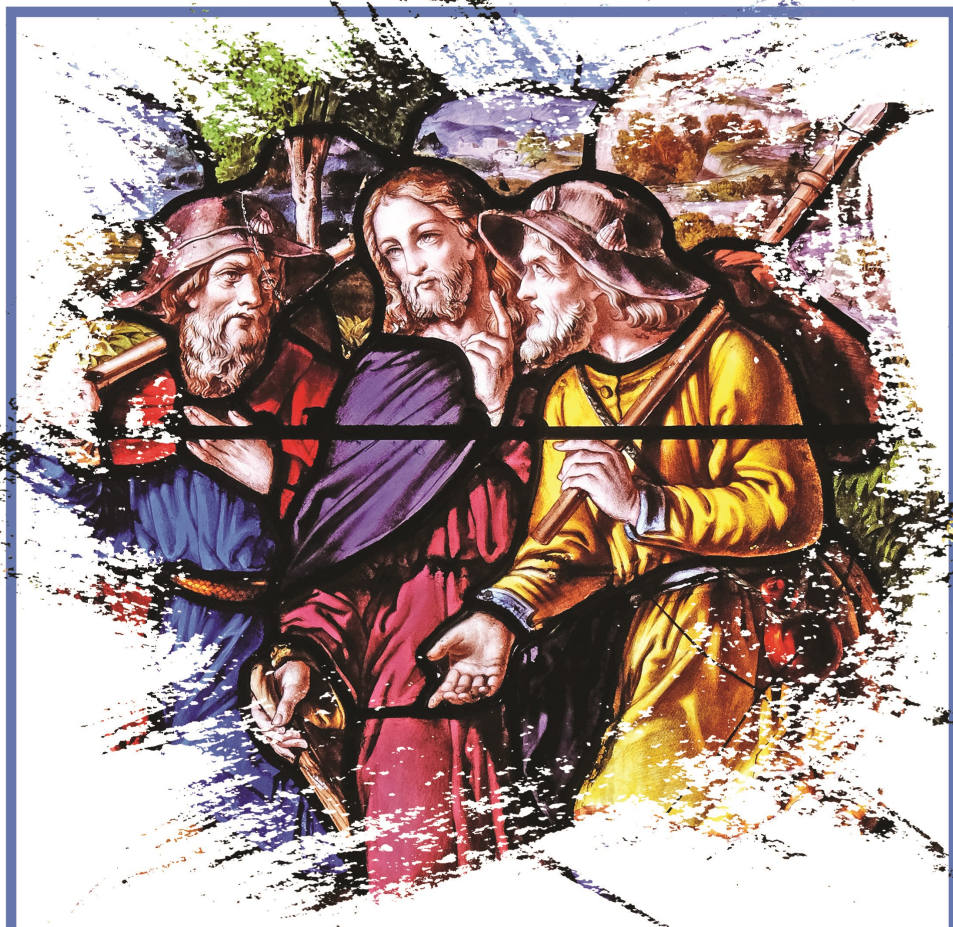

Dear Parishioners,

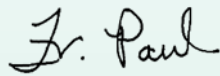
