St. Mary and St. Joseph Covid-19 Update, June 2021

- 1. Hymnals and missalettes will be put back in the pews.
- 2. Masses for the Vulnerable: Lebanon 4:30 PM and Frankfort 6:00 PM
 - Masks and social distancing required.
 - No Holy Water in the fonts.
 - No congregational singing but use one accompanist and one cantor.
- 3. All music can return to normal except at 4:30 PM Lebanon and 6:00 PM Frankfort.
- 4. Encourage but not require social distancing and masks at all other times.
- 5. No cleaning of pews after each Mass, disinfect high touch areas weekly.
- 6. Clean Holy Water Fonts on Mondays, do not fill the baptistries.
- 7. Bread and Wine continue to be on the credence table in the sanctuary.
- 8. Collection taken up as usual, use pole style baskets.
- 9. Leave an entrance door open so folks can just walk in.
- 10. No Precious Blood will be distributed to the faithful.
- 11. Hand Sanitizer and masks will be available at the doors.
- 12. Sign of Peace without physical contact.
- 13. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion will wear a mask and use hand sanitizer prior to and after distribution.
