Happy Easter! Jesus is Risen, and has given us new life in Himself. That is truly the best news ever!

When Jesus walked this Earth in His three years of public ministry; His impact and time to spend with people was necessarily limited. He had time to really form and "pour into" His twelve apostles and a handful of women who accompanied Him throughout His ministry. Probably only around 10,000 – 15,000 heard Jesus preach firsthand.

By Rising from the Dead and Ascending into Heaven, however, Jesus is NOW infinitely available to any person who wants to know Him. It was strategically the strongest move God could have made to be maximally available to His people. Jesus is present in the Eucharist, and also whenever we call upon Him. God is closer to us than we are to ourselves, but we have to cultivate the awareness of how the Lord is tapping us on the shoulder on a daily basis. How is Jesus walking with me now? This focus on daily encounters has, in fact, been our parish focus at St. Luke this past program year.

Our Easter gift to you is the book *Holy Moments* which nicely echoes the same theme. I hope you will consider reading at least the prologue. It's a very relatable story on how living life with an understanding and expectation that Jesus is near to us can be transformative and give us a great sense of joy.

I hope and pray this Easter Season abounds with holy moments. My prayers are with you and your families in this holy season.
