Family Promise's program relies on the partnership of 26 houses of worship that are committed to helping local families facing homelessness. Local churches provide temporary overnight lodging in unused spaces in their buildings one week at a time approximately 4 times a year.

St Bernadette's/SVDP has chosen to be a support church and will be working with Stockton Covenant Church which will be the host site. They are located just down the street from us on Bristol off Country Club. We have already been assigned our first rotation which is the week of May 29th.

Families stay overnight and during the day kids are shuttled to school and other family members head to the local day center as they work with a director at the center to seek employment, housing and other resources to gain their independence. At the center they also have the opportunity to do laundry and take showers.

Families stay in the program until they are back on their feet and have their own housing. Most families are out on their own within 8 weeks.

Volunteers are the core of this program and in the evenings when the families arrive back at the host site, volunteers are needed to provide the evening meals, groceries for both breakfast and lunch and to spend the evening with families, talking, tutoring kids or playing games. Each day ends with the family all together, under one roof.

Please consider volunteering with us and making a difference in our community. We will be taking volunteer sign-ups during March and April. Please contact Diana Costa or the church office.

Dear Missionary Disciples of St. Bernadette's family,

Today the Church is celebrating Palm Sunday, which is also known as Passion Sunday, to commemorate the beginning of Holy Week and Jesus' final agonizing journey to the cross. The word passion comes from a Latin word, Passio, meaning "to suffer," and we meditatively go with the sufferings of Jesus. Here we have the rejoicing with the coming of Jesus and at the same time a reminder of his suffering that is to come in a short time. In the liturgical calendar, Holy Week begins with the Sixth Sunday in Lent. Palm Sunday reminds the faithful of the glorious and triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. As Jesus entered Jerusalem, the crowds greeted him with shouts of joy and proclaimed him the messianic king. They spread their cloaks on the ground and placed the palm branches on the street and shouted "Hosanna to the Son of David" and "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord". The Gospels tell us that Jesus rode into the city on a donkey, as foretold by prophet Zachariah, and in so doing emphasized the humility that was to characterize the Kingdom he proclaimed. In biblical times, the regional custom called for kings and nobles to arrive in a procession riding on the back of a donkey. The donkey was a symbol of peace and those who rode upon them proclaimed peaceful intentions. The laying of palm branches indicated that the king or dignitary was arriving in victory or triumph.

As people of God we have made it to Palm Sunday. Some of us can't wait for the Lenten penance to be over with, many might have enjoyed the time of grace through prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Whatever the situation, I'm glad as people of God, we are entering into HOLY WEEK, which allows us to participate in the holy passion and finally the RESURRECTION of Jesus. Indeed this week is a sacred and precious moments of our Catholic Faith. Therefore, I encourage all of you to take part in all activities this week specially on HOLY THURSDAY where we commemorate the day that Jesus instituted the Eucharist, Priesthood and servanthood. On this day we learn to imitate our Master to love and serve the people of God. HOLY FRIDAY marks the remarkable day in the life of the Church where Jesus offered himself to be crucified and die for our sins. Finally, EASTER VIGIL celebration, recalls to our mind that we are resurrected children of God.
