- What Sacrament (s) have you been preparing to receive?
   The Sacrament of Confirmation

- 3. What are some effects of Confirmation?

A special outpouring of the Holy Spirit, that impresses on the soul and indelible character and produces growth of the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Unites us more firmly to Christ and to the Church. Strengthens to be witnesses of the Christian faith.

- 4. How does confirmation help us to live as disciples of Jesus?
  Confirmation unites us more perfectly to the Church and we are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. We become true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread, and defend the faith by word and deed. CCC 1285
- How many times can you receive Confirmation?You can only receive this sacrament once. It lasts forever.
- 6. What is an indelible spiritual mark?
  A special character that is permanent source of grace. God's way of making a permanent commitment, to us by deepening His covenant made to us at Baptism.
- 7. How do you prepare to receive Confirmation? Attend and fully participate in all Confirmation classes and activities. Attend Mass every Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation. Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation before Confirmation Mass.
- 8. What are the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit?
  Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord.
- What sacraments do you celebrate before Confirmation?Baptism, Reconciliation and Holy Communion

10. What happened to Peter and the apostles after they were filled with the power of the Holy Spirit?

Peter and the Apostles proclaimed God's mighty deeds. Those who believed in the Apostle's preaching were baptized and received the Holy Spirit through the laying on of hands.
