## Thank you! Thank you!

"Has none but this foreigner returned to give thanks to God?"

(Taken from today's gospel reading: Luke 17:11-19)

When we pray and ask God for the things we need, that's a genuine act of faith. But that's only the first act, as in a play with two parts. The second act of faith is being grateful for what we already have and for what we receive in the future. Whatever that may be.

All ten lepers show faith enough in Jesus to ask him for healing. It's pretty amazing that they believed Jesus could do what no doctor had been able to do. But only one of them completes the circle of faith by returning to thank Jesus for what *is* done for him. As usual, he's the least likely one to do so: a Samaritan outsider. So while everyone walks away a winner here – the healing of the other nine isn't reversed – only the Samaritan is saved in a deeper, more permanent way. Saying "thank you" to God is not an afterthought or an option. It's the other side of asking. It's how we know our prayer is truly finished.
