Weekly Reflection

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus appears before a group of humble fishermen as they go about the routine of their day. They have no idea what is about to unfold. And yet, Christ steps into their ordinary lives and invites them to follow him—to become fishers of men.

In much the same way, we encounter Christ in daily life, often in the least expected moments. Jesus' invitation is a kind of holy play-on-words: fishermen become fishers of men. Their work would no longer be centered on themselves alone. Even when they returned to their nets throughout the Gospels, their lives were never the same. They had discovered a purpose beyond themselves.

This week, I invite you to reflect on the ways you have served the Lord by serving others. How has that service shaped you? How has it touched the lives of those you encountered? What gifts of insight, healing, or peace might Christ have offered through those moments?
