Weekly Reflection

Dear Friends,

As we continue our Lenten journey, the Church invites us this Sunday to ascend the mountain of the Transfiguration, where Jesus reveals His hidden glory to a few trusted disciples. It is a moment of breathtaking clarity before the road turns toward suffering, a reminder that God does not lead us into difficulty without first anchoring us in hope. Abram's call to leave everything familiar shows us that faith often begins with a step into the unknown, trusting not in a clear destination but in the One who calls us forward.

Many of us know what it is like to wish we could remain in moments when God feels especially close, when life makes sense and peace seems secure. Yet Jesus gently leads the disciples back down the mountain into ordinary life, carrying within them the memory of light that will sustain them in darker hours. Lent offers us that same invitation: to draw near to Christ in prayer, to listen more deeply for His voice, and to allow His presence to strengthen us for whatever lies ahead.

If this season feels more like a wilderness than a mountaintop, take heart. The God who calls you beyond what is comfortable walks beside you every step of the way. The glory revealed in Christ is not meant to dazzle us from a distance but to transform us from within, shaping us into people of courage, compassion, and hope.

May this week be an opportunity to pause, to listen, and to trust that even in uncertainty, God is preparing something beautiful in your life.
