## Weekly Reflection

Anyone who has experienced a dry summer knows what thirst looks like. The earth cracks, the fields fade, and everyone begins to look toward the sky hoping for rain. In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus meets a woman at a well who carries a deeper kind of thirst—the longing to be known, forgiven, and made whole. Rather than avoiding her story, Jesus gently reveals it and offers something far greater than the water she came to draw: the living water of God's mercy.

The truth is that we all carry this same spiritual thirst. We search for fulfillment in many places, yet our hearts ultimately long for the love and grace that only Christ can give. Lent invites us to return to the well—to meet Jesus again in prayer, reconciliation, and the Eucharist, where His living water continues to flow.

This week, take a moment to ask yourself: Where in my life am I still thirsty, and where might Christ be waiting to meet me at the well?
